

MINUTES OF JULY 28, 1942.

An adjourned regular meeting of the Council was held on Tuesday, July 28th, 1942, at 8 o'clock P.M. Present: Councilmen White, Mason, Von Rotz, Carroll and Linch.  
Mayor Linch presiding.

The minutes of the meeting of July 14th, 1942 were approved as read.

A petition bearing the signatures of 78 property owners in the district, urging Council to repair the foot bridge connecting Karl and Calumet Avenues, and reopen the same for public use at the earliest possible date was read and filed.

On motion of Councilman Von Rotz, seconded by Councilman Carroll, and unanimously passing, said bridge was ordered repaired at once.

Mr. Myers, representing a group in his district, informed Council that recent owners are contemplating relocation of certain portions of Scenic Avenue which would interfere with their property lines. It was agreed that the City Attorney would view the location to determine the status.

A communication was received from the County Grand Jury recommending that the City Insurance structure be analyzed with the view towards eliminating any duplications and obtaining strict economies.

A communication was received from the Minto and Wilkie Insurance Company advising Council that recommendations of the Grand Jury have been complied with in handling the Town's insurance structure.

WARRANTS:

On motion of Councilman Carroll, warrants Nos. 7270 to 7277, incl., were ordered paid. Motion was seconded by Councilman White and carried by the following vote: Ayes: Councilmen White, Mason, Von Rotz, Carroll and Linch.  
Noes: None.

The Attorney submitted a Title report on property in the Town recently abandoned by the N.W.P.R.R. Co. and the Attorney was authorized to contact record owners of such property with the view towards acquiring such property for the Town.

The Fire Chief reported that the Railroad right of way between Bolinas and Ross Avenues presented a fire hazard and should be burned but was unsuccessful in receiving an expression from the Railroad Company. The Mayor agreed to contact Mr. Veale with the view towards having the Railroad Company carry out its obligations in the matter.

A vote of thanks was extended Mr. Arthur Justis for furnishing plumbing fixtures used in the City Park at invoice prices, and furnishing all labor in connection with installation, etc., and the Clerk was instructed to so notify Mr. Justis.

Councilman Von Rotz recommended the appointment of a board of Park Commissioners for the purpose of promoting some activity towards the improvement of the City Park. He was authorized to appoint such a committee.

Following the recommendation of Councilman Von Rotz, Council ordered the posting of a notice and the removal of an obstruction from the Creek area adjoining Caletti's service station.

On motion of Councilman Von Rotz, seconded by Councilman Carroll, and unanimously passing, a \$10.00 per month increase in the salary of Chas. Cartwright was granted, effective as of August 1st, 1942.

Some discussion was had in connection with a culvert on Redwood Road, and it was agreed that Councilman Von Rotz and the Superintendent of Streets will view the location and make their recommendation as to the proper location of said culvert.

There being no further business, the meeting was adjourned to Tuesday, August 11th, 1942, at 8 o'clock P.M.
