RENT CONTROL BY CITIES.

An unsigned card <sup>was rec'd</sup> asking the City Council to enact legislation to control rent prices <sup>in the City</sup> subsequent to the death of Federal Law, OPA. No action was taken on the advise of the City Attorney, inasmuch that he believed it was outside the jurisdiction of this City Council.

ORDINANCE #294. AN ORDINANCE REGULATING THE RECTION, CONSTRUCTION, ENLARGEMENT, ALTERATION, REPAIR, MOVING, REMOVAL, DEMOLITION, CONVERSION, OCCUPANCY, EQUIPMENT, USE, HEIGHT, AREA, AND MAINTENANCE OF BUILDINGS AND OR STRUCTURES IN THE TOWN OF SAN ANSELMO; PROVIDING FOR THE ISSUANCE OF PERMITS AND COLLECTION OF FEES THEREFOR; DECLARING AND ESTABLISHING FIRE DISTRICTS; PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR THE VIOLATION THEREOF, AND REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES AND OR PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT THEREWITH; AND FOR THAT PRUPOSE ADOPTING THE UNIFORM BUILDING CODE 1946 EDITION AS PREPARED BY PACIFIC COAST BUILDING OFFICIALS' CONFERENCE WITH CERTAIN MODIFICATIONS AND EXCEPTIONS.

Following the reading of the title, upon motion of Councilman Monte, seconded by Councilman Miller, it was duly <sup>adopted</sup> ~~decided~~ that further reading be dispensed with. Upon motion of Councilman Miller, seconded by Councilman Smith, Ordinance No. 294 was duly passed and adopted.

RESOLUTION #416 - ACCEPTING DEED FROM NORTHWESTERN PACIFIC RAILROAD CO.

TORNELL SUBDIVISION - MONTEREY SUBDIVISION.

Upon motion of Councilman Love, seconded by Councilman Allen, it was duly ~~passed~~ <sup>adopted</sup> that the formalities of acceptance of the final map for the Tornell Subdivision on Monterey Boulevard be completed as soon as all details were settled to the satisfaction of the City ~~Attorney~~ <sup>Engineer</sup>.

SCORE BOARD AT BASEBALL PARK - MAINTENANCE OF GRANDSTAND.

Upon motion of Councilman Smith, seconded by Councilman Allen, it was duly passed that a score board be erected at the baseball park. It was suggested that Councilman Miller look over the condition of the grandstand to the end that any necessary maintenance be done.

PICTURES - ASSESSORS RECORDS.

Upon motion of Councilman Smith, seconded by Councilman Love, the Assessor was ordered to have pictures taken of all of the buildings within the city in order that he be able to maintain more satisfactory assessment records. It was understood the price would be forty cents per picture.


GREYHOUND OPERATIONS AND BUS STOPS.
