DISCUSSION OF THE FINANCIAL PROGRAM FOR THE YEAR ENDING JUNE 30, 1948, as announced by the Mayor, was the sole purpose of the meeting.

Gentlemen:

On behalf of the two hundred twenty members of The San Anselmo Progressive Improvement Club, we wish to thank you for the kind and prompt consideration given us in regards to the study of the San Anselmo financial program for the year 1947/1948.

May we propose the following:

STREET DEPARTMENT:

Reduce the personnel to 4 good efficient hard working men to the extent of increasing salaries to obtain your goal of saving the taxpayers \$3,600.00 per year.

POLICE DEPARTMENT:

39-38-19

Reduce the personnel to 8 good efficient hard working men including the Chief of Police to the extent of increasing salaries to obtain your goal of saving the taxpayers \$6,000.00 per year.

Eliminate the Police reserve to save \$2,600.00 per year.

FIRE DEPARTMENT:

17-38-19

Eliminate additions and replacements to the extent of those that are absolutely necessary to save \$1,200.00 per year.

ADMINISTRATIVE DEPARTMENT:

38

Reduce personnel to two full time efficient hard working people to save \$2,700.00 per year.

Eliminate unnecessary expenditures as City obligations to save a further \$1,200.00 per year.

The total of the above amounts to \$17,300.00 per year saving to the San Anselmo taxpayers which will give you a surplus to the proposed budget that you are to pass upon tonight.

It is noted that no consideration has been given to the future recession with a decrease in costs and expenses to the City.

The taxpayers are faced with a readjustment of income which they try to spread out to meet all their just obligations.

Your usual cooperative consideration will be justly appreciated.
