MINUTES OF THE ADJOURNED MEETING OF JUNE 22, 1948 were read  
and approved.

INSTALLATION OF STREET LIGHTS at and about the Wye, intersection of Sir Francis Drake with Bridge, and with Redhill, and with Railroad Avenue and with Greenfield, was duly approved following the motion of Councilman Booth, seconded by Councilman Miller and provides for installation as follows: 47

5-600 cp, change of 2-100 cp to 600 cp and change of 1-100 cp to 250 cp.

IMPROVEMENT OF THE SOUTHERLY PORTION OF MIRACLE MILE was duly authorized following the motion of Councilman Booth, seconded by Councilman Miller, and the Superintendent of Streets was authorized to install about forty feet of culvert for a cross street, remove one or more trees, set up redwood posts and fill in for a bus stop. 45

SPEED ALLOWABLE ON THE "MIRACLE MILE" was discussed and it was agreed that the Chief of Police would confer with the City of San Rafael to make same uniform and in accord with a new state law in the matter. 53

STREET WORK-VARIOUS-Report submitted by the Superintendent of Streets for about seventeen different jobs at an estimated cost of about \$2,800. Upon the motion of Councilman Booth, seconded by Councilman Miller, this work was authorized. 45

CHANGES IN CIVIL SERVICE ORDINANCE in which it was proposed

at the meeting of June 22nd, 1948, that certain titles would be removed from Civil Service - upon the motion of Councilman Booth, seconded by Councilman Miller the proposed change was tabled for later discussion. Said action received the following vote:
