

MINUTES OF THE MEETING HELD JANUARY 13th 1953

A regular meeting of the San Anselmo City Council was held at the City Hall, San Anselmo on January 13th 1953 at 8:00 P.M.

Mrs. G.G. Sill, 19 Roger Ave., Spoke regarding drainage conditions City Attorney to investigate same and report to council.

APPLICATION OF GLENN WENTZ, 54 Park Drive -On motion of Councilman Hannigan -Authorizing necessary adjustments and grant Mr. Wentz permission to build. Motion seconded by Councilman Smith. Adopted on the following vote:

MR. STANLEY BISS, 20 ANGELA COURT -Regarding lights on Angela & Shiela Cts. P.G. & E.Co., has order to install same and as soon as weather permits matter will be taken care of.

MR. C.O. NEILL - Addressed Council regarding Stop Signs on Broadmoor Ave., On recommendation of Chief Wood Stop signs be erected to require all autos to stop before entering Broadmoor on both sides of Meadowcroft & Morningside Court. Motion made to adopt resolution by Councilman Smith seconded by Councilman Hannigan.

APPLICATION FOR ADJUSTMENT: Frank Antonioli, Longview Ave., requesting 10' setback granted on recommendation of Planning Commission on motion of Councilman Skinner seconded by Councilman Hannigan.

LETTER OF SELMA HOPE: Regarding Sewer Easement, ^{revised} Council upholds decision of Planning Commission.

APPLICATION FOR ADJUSTMENT: Dave Bartholow requesting 9' setback granted on recommendation of Planning Commission on motion of Councilman Hannigan seconded by Councilman Smith.

CROSSING GUARDS - Letter from School District regarding crossing guards. Council will meet with Mr. Forry regarding hiring of a man approximately 15 Hrs. per week @ 1.50 per hour. Mr. Buresh read letter from D.A. that City has no legal responsibility to pay for school crossing guards.

REQUEST FOR "NOT A THROUGH STREET" SIGN: Mrs. Wm. Schoenfeld, 14 Beverly Ave. for "Not a through street" sign. Councilman Smith moves that sign be erected, seconded by Councilman Parmelee.

CITY OF FAIRFAX - Letter regarding flood conditions on Sir Francis Drake Blvd. and Suffield Ave. City Engineer states this is no time to do any work. City Council would like to meet with Mayor Elliott of Fairfax to discuss this matter further.

RESOLUTION NO. 596 Resolving that Stopping, Standing or Parking be prohibited at all times on both sides of unnamed public easements in Lincoln Park Subdivision. Councilman Parmelee moves that resolution be adopted, seconded by Councilman Hannigan.

RESOLUTION NO. 597 Calling examinations for eligible list in the Dept of Police in the classified service of the Town of San Anselmo, as provided for in Ordinance No. 244 of the Town of San Anselmo. Councilman Smith moves resolution be accepted, seconded by Councilman Hannigan.

RESOLUTION NO. _____ Finding that public convenience and necessity demand rezoning in the Town of San Anselmo of a certain section of the city from R1 to R2 and directing the City Planning Commission to hold public hearings in connection therewith. City Council suggests that this resolution be tabled for the present time, and arrangements be made to meet with the Planning Commission and invite Mrs. Mary Summers to attend this meeting in advisory capacity.

LETTER FROM CHIEF OF POLICE - regarding condition of two police cars. After discussion Councilman Smith moves that bids be opened, seconded by Councilman Parmelee. Adopted on the following vote

Ayes: Councilmen - Parmelee, Smith, Cudworth

Noes: Councilman - Hannigan

Councilman Skinner passes. Bids from J.E. French Co., R & R Motor Co and Rossi Bros. Garage were opened. Councilman Smith moved bid of R & R Motor Co. amounting to \$2476.48 be accepted subject to their delivering same within 14 days. Motion seconded by Councilman Parmelee. Adopted on the following vote Ayes: Councilman Parmelee, Smith, Cudworth, Skinner - Noes: Councilman Hannigan.

MR. BRIGHAM, CITY ENGINEER -made verbal resignation and will submit written resignation at next Council meeting.

BIDS FOR GASOLINE -Bids were opened to supply Town of San Anselmo with gasoline for the coming year. Councilman Skinner read bids from the following Companies:

after reading all bids Councilman Skinner moved we enter into negotiations with Marin Petroleum Distributing Co. who were low bidders. Motion seconded by Councilman Hannigan.

Warrants #4033 to 4101 approved and ordered paid by Councilman Skinner seconded by Councilman Hannigan.

PROPOSED SIGN ORDINANCE -having been amended, received first reading by title only. Councilman Hannigan moves Council dispenses with full reading Councilman Smith seconds same. After much discussion Councilman Skinner moves Ordinance be accepted seconded by Councilman Hannigan.

CITY ATTORNEY read letter regarding property of B.H. Schmitt, Lincoln Park regarding construction of sidewalk by City on his property without permission. Letter referred to Councilman Parmelee for investigation.

CITY ATTORNEY - spoke regarding - drains- private property- proposes Ordinance making it necessary to get a permit from City Engineer for work, etc.

Business License Ordinance not completed - will report further.
