

MINUTES OF THE REGULAR MEETING HELD JUNE 9th 1953

A regular meeting of the San Anselmo City Council was held at the City Hall San Anselmo, Tuesday June 9th, 1953 at 8:00 P.M.

Present Councilman - Hannigan, Smith, Skinner, Parmelee, Cudworth
Absent: Councilman None

Mayor Cudworth, Presiding.

Minutes of the meeting held May 12th 1953, read and approved.

LETTER MEL LONDON - residents of Stone Court asking that a Street light be installed in Stone Court - Councilman Parmelee and Chief Marcucci will check same - also request for "Not Thru" street sign be installed at the foot of Stone Court, On motion of Councilman Parmelee and seconded by Councilman Smith this sign be installed. Passed unanimously.

MARIN MUNICIPAL WATER DIST - letter giving cost of installing along Redwood Rd 625 feet of 6" C.I. Pipe and (1) 4-inch hydrant at cost of \$2,442.53. Matter to be referred to Mr. Buresh. Letter sent to residents of Redwood Rd. that matter has been referred to City Attorney.

KENNETH M. FORRY letter regarding right of way or easement for drainage purposes near Isabel Cook School, matter referred to City Attorney for further investigation.

MR. SUTHERLAND, 5 Suffield Ave. asking permission to move a small trailer house on the rear of his property to be used by his wife during the day who is in poor health. Chief Wood to check and report further.

R.E. MULLINS - letter from Planning Commission with reference to R.E. Mullins property, as property is presently zoned 2nd residential, legally they are not within their rights to grant a Use Permit. Matter referred to City Attorney Buresh for legal advise on same.

E.C. ROBERTS - regarding bulkhead on Butterfield Rd - Mr. Oglesby will have to get a pile driver from the city to do work. Mr. Oglesby will have plans ready for next council meeting. Mr. Roberts asked that stop sign on Butterfield and Arroyo be put back. Chief Wood is checking this area at the present time.

RESOLUTION #605 - Authorizing the payment for certain equipment for Civil Defense purposes on a matching basis of Federal, State and City Funds. Councilman Smith moves this resolution be adopted. Councilman Hannigan seconds same. Passed unanimously.

Councilman Hannigan moves Fred Hines be re-appointed to Library Board, Councilman Smith seconds same.

Councilman Parmelee moves Valerie Ansel be re-appointed to Library Board, Councilman Hannigan seconds same.

Councilman Parmelee moves Miss Grace Cornwall be appointed to Library Board to fill vacancy left by the resignation of Mrs. O.W. Jones, Councilman Smith seconds same. Passed unanimously by Council.

On motion of Councilman Skinner and seconded by Councilman Hannigan, Merritt Webster be re-appointed Chairman of the City Planning Commission - Term to expire ~~April~~ 18th 1957.

COUNCILMAN SMITH moves Council accept with regret letter of resignation from Herman E. Brower from the Fire Department. Councilman Hannigan seconds same. Passed unanimously by Council.

On motion of Councilman Smith and seconded by Councilman Hannigan, the examination for Fire Dept. having been prepared and conducted be approved and the name of Richard Lamb be placed on the eligible list of Firemen in the classified service of the Town of San Anselmo having a passing grade of 84.6%. Passed unanimously by Council.

COUNCILMAN SMITH moves Richard Lamb having successfully passed the Civil Service Examination be permanently appointed to the Classified Service of the Town of San Anselmo, starting salary \$326.00. Councilman Hannigan seconds same. Passed unanimously.

On motion of Councilman Parmelee the examination for Laborer's having been prepared and conducted be approved. The following applicants having passed the examination be placed on the eligible list. Samuel Riboli 85.59% and Joseph Riboli 76.29%. Councilman Smith seconds same. Passed unanimously.

COUNCILMAN PARMELEE moves Joseph Riboli and Samuel Riboli having successfully passed the Civil Service Examination for Laborer's be permanently appointed to the Classified Service of the Town of San Anselmo, starting salary \$271.00 Councilman Hannigan seconds same. Passed unanimously.

On motion of Councilman Smith the Examination for Patrolmen having been prepared and conducted be approved and the following applicants having passed the examination be placed on the eligible list:

- John Nielson - 84.65%
- Joseph Appell - 80.92%
- Arthur Swenson - 74.42%
- Paul T. Morris - 89.21%
- Newall Snyder - 81.30%
- L. Halpin - 79.60%

Councilman Hannigan seconds same. Passed unanminously.

The matter of the property of Arthur Wynne to be referred to Mr. Buresh on his return.

RESIGNATION read from Councilman Charles Parmelee effective June 15th, Councilman Skinner moves this resignation be accepted with regret. Councilman Smith seconds same. Letter of thanks to be written to Councilman Parmelee. Passed unanimously by Council.

BIDS - were read for the spraying of Elm Trees - Sohner Tree Service bid for spraying .050 per gallon applied to Elm Leaf and .065 per gallon applied to aphids or scale insects. Morrison Tree Experts bid of (.055) 5 1/2 cents per gallon for spraying all Elm trees and (.055) 5 1/2 cents for aphids if necessary. Council Skinner moves that Council accept Sohner's bid for 5¢ for spraying Elm Trees and Morrison's bid of 5 1/2¢ for control of aphids. Councilman Hannigan seconds same. Passed unanimously.

On motion of Councilman Parmelee, clerk be authorized to draw up a Resolution calling for examination to create an eligible list for the Street and Fire Depts. in the Classified Service of the Town of San Anselmo. Councilman Smith seconds same. Passed unanimously.

VALLERGA PROPERTY - Mayor Cudworth will talk to Mr. Vallergera regarding this matter.

THE ALAMEDA - Mr. Oglesby spoke regarding the Alameda - letter to be sent to Mr. Buresh to investigate legal matter.

MR. PARMELEE -spoke regarding curbing on Hilldale Ave. ^{from Galatone} Party who owns house will pay 50% - Leach will pay 25% and city will pay 25% when work is to be done - Mr. Oglesby will check further.

COUNCILMAN SKINNER moves Warrants #4335-4382 inclusive be paid -Councilman Hannigan seconds same.

FINANCE CHAIRMAN SKINNER spoke on current assessment on personal property tax in the business area being completely inequitable and unfair - after much discussion by Council -Councilman Skinner moves that when the Council sits as a Board of Equalization they re-assess the business personal property tax, Councilman Hannigan seconds this motion. Motion failed to carry on the following vote:

CHIEF WOOD asked clerk to send letter of thanks to all who assisted in the recent Civil Service Examintions.

Request for one hour parking signs from Northwesterly side of Greenfield Ave. from Sir Francis Drake Blvd. to Lincoln Ave - Councilman Smith moves this request be granted - Councilman Parmelee seconds same. Passed Unanimously.
