

A regular meeting of the San Anselmo City Council was held at the City Hall San Anselmo on September 8th, 1953 at 8:00 P.M.

Present: Councilmen - Hannigan, Smith, Skinner, Wadlewski, Cudworth  
Absent: Councilmen - None

Mayor Cudworth, presiding.

Minutes of the meeting of August 25, 1953 read and approved.

Due to the absence of City Attorney Buresh, the matter of the PG&E franchise was postpone until the next council meeting.

PUBLIC HEARING ON REZONING FROM FIRST RESIDENTIAL TO SECOND RESIDENTIAL -  
Lots 2-4-6-8-10-12-14 Lincoln Park, Councilman Smith asks to be disqualified from speaking or voting on this matter. Mr. Thayer representing residents opposing this rezoning, presented a petition signed by 31 residents. Mr. Geo Washburn called on Mr. Troth who spoke in favor of rezoning this section. Mr. Carey also spoke in favor of same. After much discussion on this rezoning Councilman Hannigan moves council overrule Planning Commission and approve the rezoning from R1 to R2 the above portion of Lincoln Park. Motion failed to carry for want of a second. Councilman Wadlewski moves council uphold the decision of the Planning Commission and deny this rezoning. Councilman Skinner seconds same. Adopted on the following vote -

NOT VOTING - Councilman Smith

MRS FRANCES McGOVERN, 75 Bella Vista Ave. regarding trees - Councilman Wadlewski has investigated this matter reporting same is a hazard and moves same be removed. Clerk to ask for bids on estimate cost of same. Councilman Skinner seconds this motion. Passed unanimously.

GERALDINE ROBSON - letter asking permission to remove 9 trees on her property on Crescent Road - Matter referred to Councilman Wadlewski to investigate.

Letter read regarding police assistance in directing traffic for Grape Festival to be held October 3rd - Matter to be referred to Chief Wood.

Street Commission Wadlewski to check condition of Redwood Road from Melville & Gerlach.

Mr. Schmidt spoke regarding Butterfield Road - Mr. Oglesby and Mr. Wadlewski to go out Saturday regarding same. Councilman Skinner feels city should get relief from county on the repair of Butterfield Road.

CALIF. STATE FIREMEN'S ASSN., - letter asking permission to use rescue wagon in parade at Santa Rosa, Councilman Smith moves permission be granted - Councilman Wadlewski seconds same.

Letter signed by 15 business men in San Anselmo regarding condition of parking lot on San Anselmo Avenue - at Pine St., Councilman Wadlewski will investigate.

Letter from Chamber of Commerce regarding "Free City Parking" in parking lot on Magnolia Ave., Action to be deferred at this time.

City Engineer Oglesby to call for bids for finishing of Cedar St., and sidewalks On motion of Councilman Skinner and seconded by Councilman Smith bids be called on the above work. Passed unanimously.

Letter from Mrs. Andrew Klapak, 27 Camino de Herrera, regarding car rolling down hill and onto her property - asked that barrier be put up. Letter to be sent Mrs Klapak telling of new Ordinance regarding parking on hills, etc.,

ACME BURGLAR ALARM CO. regarding business license fee. Letter referred to City Attorney Buresh for investigation.

City Engineer checked the above bids. On motion of Councilman Skinner high bid of Tinkler Equip. Co. be accepted. Councilman Hannigan seconds same. Passed Unanimously.

APPLICATION FOR ADJUSTMENT - Serafino Paolino, 123 Calumet Ave., letter read from Gordon Smith Attorney for above party. Councilman Smith reported Mrs. Paolino asks that application be withdrawn.

APPLICATION FOR ADJUSTMENT - Caornelius Van Vuren, 65 Alder Ave asking adjustment for erection of garage. Councilman Smith moves to uphold Planning Commissions decision and grant this adjustment. Councilman Hannigan seconds same. Passed unaminously.

On motion of Councilman Skinner, Mrs. Asay be reclassified class #12 and Mrs. Gannon reclassified to class #15. Councilman Wadlewski seconds same. Passed unaminously by council.

On motion of Councilman Hannigan approval be granted for the temporary appointment of Anita C. Gannon as office clerk effective, September 1, 1953. Councilman Smith seconds same. Passed unaminously.

Councilman Smith moves Lawrence Antolini be appointed to serve on the Board of Review filling vacancy left by Peter Helms. Term to expire January 15, 1958.

Councilman Wadlewski moves Thomas McGuire be appointed to serve on the Board of Review filling vacancy left by Louis Cummings. Term to expire Jan.15,1956. Councilman Hannigan seconds same. Passed unaminously.

On motion of Councilman Hannigan application of C.J. Allen Cab Co., to renew certificate to operate taxicabs in the Town of San Anselmo be granted. Councilman Skinner seconds same. Passed unaminously.

On motion of Councilman Hannigan bids be called for culvert of 200 Ft to be installed at recreation park. Councilman Wadlewski seconds same. Passed Unam.

City Engineer & Street Supt. to investigate underpinings on Bridge on Sir. Francis Drake Blvd.

Councilman Skimmer moves warrants #4513 to 4564 be paid. Councilman Wadlewski seconds same. Passed unaminously.
