

A regular meeting of the San Anselmo City Council was held at the City Hall San Anselmo on October 13th, 1953 at 8:00 P.M.

Reading of the minutes of the meeting held September 8th, 1953 dispensed with.

Mrs. Carmel Booth spoke on civilian defense in San Anselmo - Letters sent to Senator McCarthy and Assemblyman McCollister regarding monies coming to city from State. Mrs. Booth thanks all who assisted with Recruitment day. Mr. Meister introduced to Council.

LETTER FROM FIRST PRESBY CHURCH regarding installing of directional sign on Sir Francis Drake & Ross Ave., council gives authority to church to erect sign. Chief Wood will follow thru also will approve location.

LETTER FROM MR. FORRY, San Anselmo School Dist. regarding watering of lawn at park. Matter referred to Mr. Hannigan who will check with Chief Marcucci and Mr. Forry regarding same.

LETTER FROM MR. FORRY, regarding loading zone for children at Wade Thomas School. City Attorney authorized to prepare amendment to Ord. 207 to provide for School Bus Zone. On motion of Councilman Wadlewski Resolution #616 restricting parking on S. side of Woodland Avenue distance 112' from Kensington Road, be accepted. Councilman Smith seconds same. Passed unanimously.

LETTER FROM WALLACE MEYER - regarding parking of garbage trucks by Victor Vallergera. Letter referred to Mr. Buresh.

SOHNER TREE SERVICE - letter submitting their price of \$25.00 for removing tree and poisoning stump at #75 Bella Vista. Clerk to write Sohner to go ahead with this work.

APPLICATION FOR ADJUSTMENT - Mrs. Flora Daneri, requesting permission to construct a carport at her property - 18 Hazel Ave. On motion of Councilman Wadlewski permission be granted Mrs. Daneri - Councilman Smith seconds same. Passed unanimously by council.

APPLICATION FOR ADJUSTMENT - Phil Walker, Berkeley & Sunview Ave. requesting change in the legal setback from 15' to 10'. On motion of Councilman Wadlewski council uphold decision of Planning Commission and grant this adjustment. Councilman Smith seconds same. Passed unanimously.

APPLICATION FOR ADJUSTMENT - Arthur Beckman, 23 Medway Road - requesting an adjustment of 12 inches from the side property line for construction of a carport. Councilman Skinner moves to uphold the decision of the Planning Commission and grant this adjustment. Councilman Wadlewski seconds same.

APPLICATION FOR ADJUSTMENT \* Woodson Realty Co. to construct house on Berkeley Ave., after much discussion the Council feels all houses in that area are built along the same lines and a house placed any other way would be out of line. As no variance could be found for the tract Councilman Wadlewski moves application be granted. Councilman Smith seconds same. Passed unanimously.

MR. CARLTON, 51 Jordan Ave., spoke regarding easement in back of property at his address and asked council if city would run equipment on this easement for street improvement and grading, etc., residence will furnish material. Councilman Skinner moves request be denied as Town is in no position to take care of this matter. Councilman Smith seconds same. Passed unanimously.

H.W. JOSLIN - presented plans for street, Councilman Wadlewski moves tentative approval of plans be approved and work be done in accordance with California Highway specifications. Councilman Skinner seconds same. Passed unaminously by Council.

ORDINANCE NO. 357 To adopt Pacific Gas & Elec. Co. Electric Franchise read in full.

On motion of Councilman Smith and seconded by Councilman Skinner, San Anselmo Yellow Cab Co., certificate to operate two (2) full time cabs in San Anselmo be approved. Passed unaminously by Council.

On motion of Councilman Smith, Officer Farmer be reclassified to Bracket 19, Range E. Salary \$341.00 per month, effective October 1st, 1953. Councilman Skinner seconds same. Passed unanimously by Council.

Councilman Skinner moves Warrants 4565-4623 incl. be paid. Council Wadlewski seconds same. Passed unaminously.

Councilman Skinner moves Mr. Hangeman be authorized to draw specifications to go with plans for additional office space and restroom. Councilman Smith seconds same. Passed unaminously.

Councilman Skinner moves that specifications be put out for formal bid on above work. Councilman Smith seconds same. Passed unaminously by council.

City Engineer spoke on condition of intersection of Redhill & Sir Francis Drake, Road in very bad condition - Councilman instructed Chief Marcucci to beging work on this interseccion.
