

A regular meeting of the San Anselmo City Council was held March 9, 1954 at 8:00 P.M. City Hall, San Anselmo, California

PRESENT: COUNCILMAN -Smith, Skinner, Wadlewski, Cudworth

On motion of Councilman Skinner, dispense with the reading of the minutes of meeting held February 9, 1954. Councilman Smith seconds same. Passed unanimously.

MARIUS LARSEN letter regarding poison oak on city property near 23 Vine St. referred to Chief Marcucci.

D. FRANK MONTE, JENNESS CHAPEL letter regarding Neon Sign. On motion of Councilman Smith and seconded by Councilman Wadlewski, Use Permit be granted on an indefinite time. Passed unanimously.

DOROTHEA ANDERSON letter of thanks for clearing and leveling road at 36 Vineyard.

PETITION signed by 8 residence of Sunnyside Ave. area protesting the number of cats maintained by Mr. Edmund A. Larock, 115 Sunnyside Ave. Matter referred to Mr. Buresh.

ANNIE M. FREDERICKS letter regarding culvert draining on her property at Millbrae Ave. near West Gate, Sequoia Park. Matter referred to Mr. Wadlewski.

MRS. HARRY CAHILL, 50 Rosemont Ave. regarding parking hazard on Rosemont Avenue On motion of Councilman Smith and seconded by Councilman Wadlewski parking be prohibited at all times on Southerly side of Rosemont Ave. Passed unanimously.

WILL PETERS letter regarding parking hazard at the end of Foothill Road. On motion of Councilman Smith parking be prohibited at all times in entire area of turnaround at the end of Foothill Road. Councilman Wadlewski seconds same. Passed unanimously. SEE RESOL # 631

ERNEST F. NUTTO letter regarding condition of tennis courts at Recreation Park Matter referred to Councilman Wadlewski.

ARTHUR W SMITH letter asking permission to sell "Safe & Sane Series" fireworks in his Ben Franklin Store this year. Councilman Skinner moves permission be granted. Councilman Wadlewski seconds same. Passed on following vote.

 Councilman Smith not voting.

FRANK CHERNE, 1 Hillcrest Court, letter regarding city owned Lot #66, Morningside Court #2, which above party is interested in purchasing. Clerk to write advising Mr. Cherne this lot is not for sale.

MR ALEX KOSTEN, 36 Canyon Road, spoke regarding draining problem on his property.

APPLICATION FOR ADJUSTMENT - Joseph F. Fillippo, 32 Woodland Ave. San Rafael, requesting permission to build on his property located S/E corner San Anselmo Ave & Sir Francis Drake Blvd. without an adjustment of 5' in the set back along Sir Francis Drake. On motion of Councilman Skinner and seconded by Councilman Smith council uphold the decision of the Planning Commission and deny this adjustment. Passed unanimously.

On motion of Councilman Smith and seconded by Councilman Wadlewski - Officer H. Matteucci be advanced \$60.00 to attend the State Juvenile Officers Conference at Sacramento, March 24th to 26th. Passed unanimously.

On motion of Councilman Smith and seconded by Councilman Wadlewski the resignation of Officer L. deLisle, Jr., from the San Anselmo Police Dept. effective March 10th, 1954 be accepted with regret.

Councilman Smith moves the approval of the appointment of Robert H. Lewis as a temporary police officer effective March 10, 1954 at a regular starting salary of \$341.00 per month, replacing Officer deLisle. Councilman Wadlewski seconds same. Passed unanimously.

Chief Wood asked that the City Council terminate the eligibility of the present eligible list for the Dept. of Police at the expiration of nine months from the date of it's certification. Councilman Smith moves above list be terminated. Councilman Wadlewski seconds same. Passed unanimously.

RESOLUTION <sup>32</sup> "Calling examination for eligible list in the Department of Police in the Classified service of the Town of San Anselmo, as provided for in Ordinance #244 of the Town of San Anselmo. Councilman Smith moves resolution be accepted. Councilman Wadlewski seconds same. Passed unanimously.

Letter from Chief Wood recommending that 8 inch curb, gutter and sidewalk be required on business property fronting on the North side of Sir Francis Drake Blvd. Matter referred to City Engineer Oglesby.

ORDINANCE #362, "An ordinance amending ordinance No. 254 as amended by Ordinance #338 of the Town of San Anselmo and changing property classification of certain property of Wm. Meagor, et al., being Lots 2A, 3A and Lots B.C.D., Lot 1, Amended Map of Bush Tract. Read in Full. On motion of Councilman Skinner and seconded by Councilman Smith above ordinance be accepted. Passed unanimously.

ORDINANCE \_\_\_\_\_, "An ordinance amending Ordinance No. 254 as amended by Ordinance No. 338 of the Town of San Anselmo and changing the property classification of certain property of August Foglia, et al., being Lot 3 Blk 2 and Lot 2 Blk 1 Map of Hawthorne Hills from First Residential (R-1 to Commercial (C.H.)). Read by Title only.

WALLACE MYERS letter regarding his client Victor Vallergera parking his trucks at property located at #70 Greenfield Ave. Also petition signed by 75 residents of Lincoln Park area against this parking - after much discussion Council instructed Clerk to advise Planning Commission to set date for Public Hearing on this matter.

RESOLUTION #629 "Calling Municipal Election on April 13th 1954 and authorizing pay for election officers at the rate of \$10.00 per day. Adopted on the motion of Councilman Smith and seconded by Councilman Skinner. Passed unanimit.

M.F. DONOHUE letter regarding dates for the paying of first and second tax installments. Matter referred to City Attorney to prepare ordinance for same.

Councilman Smith moves J.E. French Company be given contract for two new police cars - Councilman Wadlewski seconds same. Passed unanimously.

MRS BERTHA LOGUE spoke regarding condition of sidewalk at 43 Ross Ave. Chief Marcucci and Attorney Buresh to investigate same.

P.F. WILLIAMS Re property matter referred to City Attorney.

On motion of Councilman Skinner warrants #4835-<sup>4887</sup>~~4877~~ excluding warrant #4872 being insurance on (2) Dodge cars as they are to be used as emergency vehicles Councilman Wadlewski seconds same. Passed unanimously.

Mr. Carlisle & Mrs. Bailey spoke regarding recreation. Clerk to write State requesting state survey on recreation - Beth Kaufman & Harry Brigioli also members of recreation board - Councilman Skinner moves \$2900.00 be approved for recreation - Councilman Wadlewski seconds same. Passed unanimously. \$250.00 be set aside of the above fund to sponsor (1) team in the Jr. League Baseball.

Letter from Mr. Boccabella regarding baseball field -referred to Mr. Carlisle.

Water main on San Anselmo Ave. between Ross & Bolinas Ave. Chief Marcucci to refer matter to Attorney Buresh who will write letter to Board of Directors of Water Dist.

Council granted to Chief Wood authority to order installation of telephones in new addition to City Hall.

Chief Wood spoke regarding lighting on S. F. Drake & Redhill. On motion of Councilman Smith (3) 20,000 Mercury Vapor Lights ordered installed at location specified by PG&E estimator. Councilman Wadlewski seconds same. Passed Unanim.

Attorney spoke regarding Perry RR property, asking warrant to be ready for meeting covering rent on same - also 1952-53 taxes be picked up. Council authorizes Mr. Buresh to enter into agreement to renew lease with Mr. Perry.

Mr. Buresh to write Mr. Ralph Benner, principal of Isabel Cook School relative to park being property of Town and as principal of the school he has no authority over use of Park.

Mr. Oglesby reported temporary repair has been made on foot bridge. Also presented 2 maps -one of Cedar St. and one of Widening of S. Francis Drake. Resolution per plans of City Engineer be prepared on motion of Councilman Skinner and seconded by Councilman Wadlewski - Passed unanimously.
