

A Regular meeting of the San Anselmo City Council was held at the City Hall April 27th 1954.

PRESENT -COUNCILMAN Booth, Ball, Washburn, Smith
ABSENT: COUNCILMAN None
Acting Mayor Smith, Presiding

Councilman Booth moves minutes of meeting held April 20th be dispensed with. Councilman Washburn seconds same. Passed unanimously.

Councilman Booth nominates Mr. Max Martin as councilman to fill the unexpired term of Fraser N. Cudworth. Councilman Washburn second same. Passed unanimously.

Councilman Martin sworn in as councilman by City Clerk.

Councilman Booth nominates Arthur W. Smith for Mayor. Councilman Washburn seconds same. Passed unanimously.

As this was the date set for the hearing on the Victor Vallergera request for storing his trucks at property located on Greenfield Ave., Mayor Smith asked to hear from anyone in the audience regarding this matter.

Mr. Meehan representing Mr. Vallergera spoke in favor of his client storing his trucks at the above address.

Mr. Wright representing residence of Lincoln Park spoke against the storing of trucks. Many residence of Lincoln Park spoke against this matter.

9:25 recess called for 5 minutes by council to talk this matter over. 9:30 meeting resumed.

Councilman Washburn moves to uphold the decision of the Planning Commission and deny this application. Motioned failed to carry for want of second.

Councilman Booth moves council deny recommendation of Planning Commission and grant this application with the following provisions.

1. No salvage or storage of refuse on premises.
2. No washing out of so called refuse on the premises.
3. That said trucks are not to enter Bank St. or Lincoln Park in residential area proper except on day specified for picking up garbage in that area.

Application of Mr. Vallergera be revoked if he does not live up to the above provisions and he will have to find another place within 30 days. Councilman Martin seconds the above motion. Passed on the following vote:

NOES - COUNCILMAN Washburn, Smith

PETITION signed by 11 residents of El Cerrito Ave. asking for a street light to be installed at the corner of El Cerrito, Oakland & Alderney Road. Matter to be held over for next meeting.

ST. ANSELM'S Convent letter regarding traffic zoning near schhol. Matter referred to Chief Wood.

MRS. J.C. UHTE, 51 Bothin Road, Fairfax, regarding Mr. Woodson dumping fill on property located at 100 Hilldale Drive, referred to Mr. Buresh.

DIVISION HIGHWAYS letter regarding Cedar Street being included in S.A. System of major city streets. On motion of Councilman Booth and seconded by Councilman Washburn, City Engineer Oglesby to go ahead on this matter after he has conferred with Councilman Ball.

On motion of Councilman Washburn Fire Chief Marcucci be granted permission to attend Northern Fire Chiefs Convention at Santa Rosa May 7th, 8th, 9th, with usual expenses paid. Councilman Booth seconds same. Passed unanimously.

Chief Marcucci to call for bids to fix council room roof which is leaking.
