



Application for Adjustment - Howard Blair, 460 Upper Scenic, permission to build a carport on property line - Councilman Washburn moves to uphold the decision of the Planning Commission and grant this application. Councilman Booth seconds same. Passed unanimously.

Application of Mrs. Elsie Turri, 37 Butterfield Road, regarding rezoning of her property. The Planning Commission felt inasmuch as this violation occurred so many years ago no action should be taken now. On motion of Councilman Martin and seconded by Councilman Booth this matter be left as it now stands. Passed unanimously.

S.A.Civic Improvement Club letter asking council to continue investigating violations of multiple dwellings in first residential areas. Clerk to write club council will continue.

H.W. deFries, PG & E representative spoke regarding poles on Cedar Street after discussion by council, City Engineer Oglesby suggested place where poles can be set.

Sunny Hills letter asking exemption from business license fee for their coming Grape Festival in October. Councilman Martin moves permission be granted. Councilman Booth seconds same. Passed unanimously.

C.H.Allen letter regarding condition of rock work at entrance gates into Lincoln Park at Bank St., Chief Marcucci to investigate this matter.

Frank Snow, 120 Humboldt Ave., letter regarding condition of road-side fence opposite this address - matter referred to Councilman Ball for investigation.

A.R. Wessell letter, regarding his filling in with dirt and concrete creek area at his residence. After discussion by council with Mr. Wessell Councilman Booth moves Mr. Wessell be allowed to leave work now done as it stands but no more work to be done. Councilman Washburn seconds same. Passed unanimously.

P.J. Cullen, present regarding complaint against him for filling in creek area at Yolanda, Councilman Booth moves Cullen be allowed to leave work he has completed as is. Councilman Washburn seconds same. Passed unan.

Councilman Booth moves the adoption of this ordinance. Councilman Martin seconds same. Passed unanimously.

RESOL.#676, "Calling examination for eligible list in the Dept. of Police in the Classified Service of the Town of San Anselmo, as provided for in Ord. No. 244 of the Town of San Anselmo. Councilman Booth moves the adoption of this resolution. Councilman Washburn seconds same. Passed unan.

#### POLICE COMMISSIONER'S REPORT

Councilman Booth moves permission be granted Lt. Serio to go to Burglar Conference at Portland, Sept. 28th, 29th and 30th. Councilman Ball seconds Passed unanimously by council. \$125.00 expenses

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Councilman Booth moves temporary policeman be hired to work Sat & Mon for temporary period. Councilman Martin seconds same. Passed unanimously.

FINANCE COMMISSIONER REPORTS

Councilman Martin moves the approval and payment of warrants #5173-5227 excepting warrant #5196. Councilman Booth seconds same. Passed unanimously.

Councilman Martin asks that all work for Town be done in San Anselmo if possible. Servicing of Police cars to be rotated between all independent stations. Councilman Martin moves 3 month trial basis at two other stations- in event work is not satisfactory then go back to original stations. Councilman Ball seconds same. Passed unanimously.

Councilman Martin moves head of each department be allowed \$25.00 expense for department, Any amount over to be OK'd by council. Councilman Booth seconds same. Passed unanimously.

Chief Marcucci asks permission to extend for another year eligible list for Fire Department now active. Councilman Washburn moves request be granted. Councilman Martin seconds same. Passed unanimously.

Councilman Booth moves City Attorney Buresh to write Brown-Ely Co., to go ahead with work on Sir Francis Drake. Minute resolution be drawn up. City's responsibility after work is completed. Councilman Washburn seconds same. Passed unanimously.

City Attorney Buresh reported case of Town vs Fuller settled for \$1000.00.

ORD # \_\_\_\_\_, "An ordinance amending ordinance No. 250 of the Town of San Anselmo entitled " An ordinance creating a Planning Commission of the Town of San Anselmo with membership powers, and duties as provided by State Law," by increasing the number of members, exclusive of Ex-Officio members, from 6 to 7. Read by title only. Councilman Booth moves to dispense with full reading. Councilman Martin seconds same. Passed unanimously.
