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MINUTES OF AN ADJOURNED MEETING OF THE SAN ANSELMO CITY COUNCIL WAS HELD NOVEMBER 16, 1954 at 8:00 P.M.

PRESENT COUNCILMEN - Booth, Ball, Martin, Washburn, Smith

ABSENT " - None

MAYOR SMITH, PRESIDING

Councilman Booth moves to dispense with reading of minutes of Nov. 9th meeting with the following correction - regarding motion made by Councilman Martin that in future if school desires to have guard or patrolman, it becomes their responsibility to pay his salary not the Town expense. Councilman Washburn amended this motion to give school 30 days notice. Councilman Washburn seconds Mrs. Booth motion. Passed unanimously by council.

Mayor Smith announced there would be no discussion on recreation at this meeting same will be brought up at meeting of December 14th.

PG & E letter regarding condition of the underground cable on San Anselmo Ave., read. Mr. Barnes representing PG & E spoke to council on this matter. Councilman Booth feels council should pursue downtown situation and attempt to pull cable at cost not to exceed \$1000.00 if possible - Town to pay additional cost - work to start as soon as possible. Councilman Washburn seconds same. Passed unanimously by council.

Matter discussed regarding missing plates from electroliers which is very dangerous. Councilman Booth moves to replace missing plates as soon as possible. Councilman Booth retracts her motion and Mr. Barnes will see what he can do regarding plates.

Mr. Knoles present at meeting reported resident's of Morningside Court satisfied with present lighting. Councilman Washburn moves no action be taken on Morningside Court or Lincoln Park at this time. Councilman Martin seconds same. Passed on the following vote:

USE PERMIT APPLICATION of C. Labar, Tunstead Ave., approved by Planning Commission. Mr. Labar's application for Use Permit to use premises at 156 Tunstead Ave, for launderette. Councilman Booth moves Use Permit be granted. Councilman Washburn seconds same. Passed unanimously.

ALBERT BELLUCCI letter protesting charge of Personal Property - Councilman Washburn moves to refund Mr. Bellucci \$2.40. Councilman Ball seconds same. Passed unanimously by council.

ENG-SKELL COMPANY letter asking exemption from paying business license for occasional delivery into San Anselmo - letter referred to City Attorney.

LETTER FROM SYDNEY MURMAN enclosing pamphlet in connection with National Safe Driving Day set for December 15th 1954. Mr. M. Kaufman was appointed Director by Mayor Smith.

KENNETH FORRY LETTER regarding school guard removed from Isabel Cook School, Councilman Booth reported on informal special meeting with school board held November 15th - matter of underpass discussed also Stop & Go signals at Sir Francis Drake & Calumet - Councilman Booth moves next four months Town to pay salary of crossing guard at Isabel Cook School started November 17th 1954. Councilman Washburn seconds same. Passed unanimously by council.

MR. WOODSON, Burchwood Park Sub-Division, spoke regarding retaining wall at Forbes Ave. Mr. Oglesby's plan reviews - right of way can be used if wall is built. Councilman Ball moves permission be granted. Mr. Woodson per plans - Councilman Booth seconds same. Passed unanimously.

Mr. Buresh spoke regarding easement near Gas Station-at Sunnyside Nursery cars parked blocking road - police Dept. instructed to give (1) last warning keep clear - leaves being dumped there - Councilman Ball said there is a definite need of culvert - catch basin on other side -barricade for this side-Councilman Ball moves after line is set up by City Engineer -street department to erect adequate barrier -Councilman Booth seconds same. Passed un-

COMMITTEE REPORTS -

Street Commissioner Ball said specifications for bids for Lincoln Park Bridge delayed as Mr. Oglesby was not present - Councilman Ball will see Mr. Oglesby- sewage leak should be investigated by Sanitary Dist. immediately - Councilman Washburn talked to Mr. Shearer (1/3) of cost by Sanitary Dist. on bridge - City Engineer to contact Sanitary Dist. board and letter or resolution written since no definite commitment has been made for exact figure.

Chief Marcucci reported on repair by street department completed at Caletta Ave. Bridge.

COUNCILMAN BOOTH brought up the matter of taking a census for San Anselmo-matter should be looked into since we are receiving gas tax on basis of 1950 census. Attorney Buresh suggests appointment of Mrs. Booth as committee of one to contact Washington regarding taking of census. On recommendation of City Attorney, Mayor Smith appointed Mrs. Booth to make necessary inquiries.

COUNCILMAN BOOTH spoke regarding Civil Defense also regarding questionnaire recently sent out - San Anselmo has led field on Civil Defense questionnaire - Mrs. Virginia Haggett appointed Mobile First Aid Unit supervisor - Councilman Booth read letter from Col. Englehart regarding physician - letter to be turned over to Mrs. Haggett to contact Col. Englehart on approval of Mayor Smith - Mayor Smith complimented Mrs. Booth on her work - questionnaires still available to City Hall.

COUNCILMAN BOOTH spoke regarding matter of all day parking in parking lot off Magnolia Ave -Chief Wood explained it serves parking problem for merchants and employees, therefore it would be a problem to limit to (2) hour parking - Councilman Washburn moves Chief Wood check parking area for about 10 days and report at next meeting. Councilman Booth seconds same. Passed unanimously. Councilman Washburn feels a sign designating "City Parking Lot" should be placed at corner of Magnolia & San Anselmo Ave. Chief Wood to contact Mr. Kaufman and discuss this further, Councilman Washburn moves to authorize Chief to erect sign. Councilman Booth seconds same. Passed unanimously.

Mrs. Foley addressed the council regarding condition of Butterfield Road - Bank being washed out - Project still in process.

Chief Marcucci reported Fire Department dormitory roof is leaking - Councilman Booth moves Chief Marcucci be authorized to get at least 3 bids for this work and take same up with Councilman Washburn. Councilman Ball seconds same. Passed unanimously.

Councilman Martin discussed fire policies - amount of insurance and whether buildings are adequately covered - Councilman Martin would like to discuss this further with Councilman Ball.

Councilman Martin moves George Franzman be hired to audit books every three months @ 650.00 per year which includes final audit. Councilman Booth seconds same. Passed unanimously by council.

Chief Marcucci reported something should be planted to hold bank from sliding on Sir Francis Drake Blvd. Mrs. Booth and Mr. Haggett will supply variegated ivy to be planted there.

CITY ATTORNEY reported on Miracle Mile - waiting for answer to his letter - work done by street department is only temporary - Also Mr. Cary's property in Lincoln Park is the same - nothing done.

CHIEF WOOD suggests center line on Miracle Mile should be painted now for safety during rainy weather. Councilman Washburn moves that Councilman Ball be authorized to get in touch with the County Road Department and see if they will put in white line for not more than \$100. Councilman Booth asked if Councilman Washburn would amend his motion to ask county if they will supply the equipment. Councilman Booth seconds same. Passed unanimously.

CHIEF WOOD spoke regarding property of Eugene Wilson known as Golf Lane, which Mr. Wilson asked that same be abandoned per minutes of May 12, 1953. Attorney Buresh will contact Mr. Wilson regarding this property.

Matter of False Arrest Policy brought up - Councilman Martin will check same and report back to council.

CHIEF WOOD spoke regarding certificates for taxi-cabs, working on temporary permits - neither firms are carrying property signs - Allen is using green station wagon and Wilson using Austin - Mayor Smith ~~Smith~~ advised both companies be instructed to comply with law at once or temporary permits will be rejected - City Attorney to contact Greyhound regarding off street parking for cabs.

CHIEF WOOD spoke regarding Butterfield Road at Sir Francis Drake Blvd. and recommends to make one way street in Northerly direction on Butterfield Road to Suffield -100' strip - Councilman Washburn moves to follow recommendation of Chief and make this strip one way- after discussion by council, Councilman Washburn withdraws his motion - matter to be continued next meeting after further investigation.

CHIEF WOOD spoke regarding Stop & Go signals at Redhill and Sequoia- which was discussed at the August meeting - Councilman Ball will have a reply at next meeting regarding property of Mrs. DeVoto.

CHIEF WOOD spoke regarding parking on Sir Francis Drake between Bridge and Madrone - same should be restricted to one hour pCouncilman Booth moves resolution be drawn restricting parking to one hour on both sides of Sir Francis Drake westerly from the intersection of Bridge to Madrone- parking be prohibited at all times on both sides of Bridge Ave. from San Anselmo Ave. to Sir Francis Drake Blvd. and on the southerly side of Sir Francis Drake from intersection of Bridge easterly to the intersection of Redhill Ave. Councilman Martin seconds same. Passed unan.

CHIEF WOOD spoke regarding 22 cases zoning violations Chief and Mr. Buresh to get together on motion of Councilman Booth - Councilman Martin seconds same. Passed unan.

Regarding 93 delinquent garbage bills - after much discussion it was suggested Mr. Buresh contact Mr. Vallergera and urge him to hire bill collector - or make some effort to contact people first - Matter referred to Mr. Buresh who will contact Mr. Vallergera.

COUNCILMAN MARTIN spoke regarding Sonome Ave. decided to bring matter up at next meeting.
