Mayor Smith called the meeting to order at 8:23 P.M.,

TAX PROTEST filed by E.M. Whisenhunt, San Francisco on property being Lot 49, Linda Vista Tract - present value \$2800. and asking that same be reduced to \$1500. due to depreciation. Councilman Ball and Cullen checked this property and Councilman Cullen moves that same be reduced \$500 on the improvements. Councilman Booth seconds same. Passed unanimously

KENNETH FORRY letter requesting that the delinquent taxes in the amount of \$29.26 against school property located at 1024 S.F. Drake formerly owned by Mary & Leo Alexander. Councilman Cullen moves to cancel taxes and clerk to notify school board of same. Councilman Booth seconds same. Passed unanimously

City Attorney spoke regarding ordinance for keeping creek-clear stating copy of this ordinance should be sent out to every property owner on main creek - Chief Marcucci should check creek from time to time and report to council - Councilman Cullen, Councilman Ball and Chief Marcucci will get together and discuss bulldozing of creek.

CHAMBER OF COMMERCE letter asking permission from City Council to erect two banners across street to advertise San Anselmo Bargain Days. Councilman Booth moves permission be granted. Councilman Cullen seconds same. Passed unanimously

Mayor Smith appoints Councilman John O'Connell as Fire Commissioner

Councilman Booth spoke on Civil Defense, stating San Anselmo will not take part in alert which will take place in near future. Chief Wood also spoke on civil defense meeting which he attended.

LETTER SAN ANSELMO CHAMBER OF COMMERCE requesting the sum of \$500 to carry on activities in San Anselmo. Councilman Booth moves to grant this request but at no time will city be responsible for any other bills, Councilman Ball seconds same. Passed unanimously

LETTER MARK-A-LINE COMPANY, SAUSALITO, regarding having to pay business license fee in San Anselmo as the work only with municipalities and do not pay license in any other city. City Atty Buresh recommends to exempt them as doing business for municipalities only. Councilman Cullen moves on recommendation of City Attorney to exempt this company. Councilman Ball seconds same. Passed on the following vote - AYES - COUNCILMEN Ball, Cullen, O'Connell, Smith
NOES - COUNCILMAN Booth

LETTER FIREMAN'S FUND - stating they do not believe the agreement between City and Sleepy Hollow Fire Protection will have any affect upon cities insurance.

RESOLUTION "That the stopping, standing or parking of vehicles be prohibited at all times day and night on both sides of S.F. Drake for a distance of 200 feet southerly from the southerly line of the intersection of Barber Avenue and Ross Avenue with said S.F. Drake Councilman Booth moves adoption of above resolution. Councilman Cullen seconds same. Passed unanimously.
