

Minutes of the regular meeting of the San Anselmo City Council held July 25, 1961
 PRESENT COUNCILMEN - Smith, Reichmuth, Little
 ABSENT COUNCILMEN - Rouse, Franchini
 Mayor Little, presiding

STREET LIGHT LINCOLN AVENUE - City Administrator recommends request for light be denied inasmuch as there are two lights already in that area. Councilman Smith having checked same would not be in favor of another light but present light volume be increased. Councilman Reichmuth moves request be denied and City Engineer check to see if volume can be increased. Councilman Smith seconds same. Passed unanimously

COOLER PROPOSALS - Proposal of \$600.00 submitted by James Allen for coolers for police and administration dept. Councilman Reichmuth moves to accept proposal. Councilman Smith seconds same. Passed unanimously

Councilman Reichmuth moves per recommendation of Chief of Police approval of two 15 minute green zones in front of First National Bank. Councilman Smith seconds same. Passed unanimously Councilman Reichmuth moves approval of Stop Sign Camino DeHerrera/Valley. Councilman Smith seconds. Passed unanum.

Chief of Police letter on traffic hazard at Tamalpais & Raymond Avenues. Matter tabled - City Administrator to contact property owner, same brought up at next meeting.

DOWNTOWN LIGHTS put over until full council is present.

LIBRARY PROGRESSPAYMENT - Councilman Reichmuth moves approval of progress payment in the amount of \$3,873.10. Councilman Smith seconds same. Passed unanimously Councilman Smith moves approval of new drinking fountain for library \$75.00. Councilman Reichmuth seconds same. Passed unanimously

Councilman Smith moves approval of the re-appointment of Leo Dwyer as a member of the Library Board. Councilman Reichmuth seconds same. Passed unanimously

Councilman Smith moves approval of the request of Lee-Mac Paving Co. to name small street off Woodside Drive "Riffa Court" with understanding contractor pay for sign. Councilman Reichmuth seconds same. Passed unanimously

ORDINANCE 473 "An ordinance amending Ord. No. 399 of the City of San Anselmo by changing the property classification from R-2 to R-3 Zone, being Lots 25 & 26 Block 2, Sunnyside Tr. property of Felice & Teresa Guasco & Michael Smith. First reading in full.

ORDINANCE 472 "An ordinance amending Ord. No. 399 of the City of San Anselmo by changing the property classification from R-1 to R-2 Zone, being parcels B & C of subdivided Lot 12, Bush Tract. Parcels A & D of Lot 12 and Lot 11, property of Allan Larkins Jr, Donald T. Thompson & Eleanora & Louis Palazzi. (First reading in full)

August 7th 1961 set for meeting of council & Mr. Kaufman, temporary chairman of Citizens Committee.

DALY CONSTRUCTION CO. - Letter appealing decision of Planning Commission for one ft variance of sideyard requirement on house being built at 16 Barber Ave - this request denied by Planning Commission - Mr. Daly addressed council on same - Mrs. Clark living next door also addressed council and asked that same be put off for two weeks so neighbors could be notified - Mr. Daly would like council to give decision so he can continue work. Councilman Reichmuth moves to uphold the decision of the Planning Commission and deny appeal. Councilman Smith seconds same. Passed unanimously

City Administrator reported on letter from Mrs. Paille, Bella Vista Ave that street department will complete paving above street in August.

Councilman Reichmuth asked City Administrator to check need for stop sign on San Anselmo Ave at Ross Ave.

City Attorney to check matter of water at Hub, Councilman Smith moves if same is a nuisance City Attorney take necessary steps to correct same. Councilman Reichmuth seconds same. Passed unanimously.
