

MINUTES OF THE REGULAR MEETING OF THE SAN ANSELMO CITY COUNCIL HELD JANUARY 23rd 1962.

PRESENT COUNCILMEN: Smith, Franchini, Reichmuth, Little
ABSENT COUNCILMAN: Rouse
Mayor Little, presiding

William Kapranos present to discuss general landscape plan for the Hub intersection suggesting several alternates. Councilman Franchini moves to authorize Mr. Kapranos to go ahead with job 5-B same not to exceed \$8,085.00. Councilman Smith seconds same. Passed unanimously

TENTATIVE MAP OF REDWOOD ROAD - RICHARD WHITE

City Administrator recommends map be re-drawn and City Engineer and Mr. White get to gether on same then refer back to Planning Commission for reconsideration. Mr. Kuechler attorney for Mrs. John Reichmuth property owner on Redwood Road stated he had no chance to go over revised map that was presented at Planning meeting and would like an opportunity to see same to see that same conforms to slope policy.

City Attorney stated as practical suggestion same go back to Planning Commission. Mayor Little moves to support City Attorney and refer same back to Planning Commission to allow interested parties to see revised plans and same conform to slope policy. Councilman Smith seconds same. Motion passed on following vote:

ABSTAINING COUNCILMAN: Reichmuth

B.F. BATES, 1554 Sir Francis Drake - appealing the decision of the Planning Commission who denied his variance for 10' min. rear yard and additional driveway also remodel present building and add 4 units. After lengthy discussion Councilman Franchini moves to uphold the decision of the Planning Commission and deny appeal. Councilman Reichmuth seconds same. Passed unanimously

CHIEF OF POLICE letter recommending that 60' of red curb be painted on the south-east corner of the intersection of Morningside Drive and San Anselmo Avenue. Councilman Smith moves approval on recommendation of the Chief. Councilman Franchini seconds same. Passed unanimously

APPLICATION OF CLARENCE E. SMITH to continue operation of taxicabs in San Anselmo, same rate as last year. Councilman Franchini moves approval of application. Councilman Smith seconds same. Passed unanimously

Councilman Reichmuth moves approval of City Administrator to attend City Manager's meeting in Riverside next month. Councilman Franchini seconds same. Passed unanimously

City Administrator reported on meeting held by members of Citizens Advisory Committee and reported on the need for a professional consultant to assist them. Councilman Reichmuth moves council approve authorization to bring consultants before citizens group for interview. Councilman Franchini seconds same. Passed unanimously

Councilman Franchini moves to advertise "Notice of Election" to be held April 10th 1962, polls to be opened from 7:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m. Councilman Reichmuth seconds same. Passed unanimously

SALARY PLAN

City Administrator recommends to council adjusting salaries to meet other communities feels 5% or one step would be justified.

Councilman Smith still feels all employees should have had a 5% increase at last budget session and he would be in favor of 5% right now.

Councilman Reichmuth feels same should be put in budget for next year.

Councilman Franchini not in favor of 5% but would go for 3%.

Councilman Smith moves across board raise for all one step effective February 1st.

Councilman Reichmuth seconds same. Motion failed on following vote:

AYES COUNCILMEN: Smith, Reichmuth

NOES COUNCILMEN: Franchini, Little

Councilman Franchini moves 5% increase effective February 1st for all excluding cashier clerk. Councilman Reichmuth seconds same. Motion passed on following vote:

AYES COUNCILMEN: Franchini, Reichmuth, Little

NOES COUNCILMAN: Smith

Councilman Reichmuth moves to dispense with reading of ordinance regulating planting of trees and ordinance turning tax collecting over to the county. Councilman Franchini seconds same. Passed unanimously

ORDINANCE "An ordinance relating to the planting, protecting, regulation and control of trees in, upon or along Public Streets, sidewalks and walkways within the City of San Anselmo. Councilman Reichmuth moves adoption of same. Councilman Franchini seconds. Passed unanimously

ORDINANCE NO. _____ "An ordinance transferring the assessment and tax collection duties, etc by the City Assessor to the Assessor and tax collector of the County of Marin and repealing all ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith. Councilman Reichmuth moves adoption of same. Councilman Smith seconds same. Passed on following vote:

AYES COUNCILMEN: Smith, Reichmuth, Little

NOES COUNCILMAN: Franchini

Mayor Little read letter from Brookside School thanking council for their visit to council meeting.

Mayor Little read letter from Mr. West on anti-communist week and ordered both filed.

Mayor Little stated due to unforeseen circumstances Councilman Rouse is resigning as a member of the city council effective as of this date. All members stated they were sorry to lose Councilman Rouse as he did an excellent job.

City Administrator read memorandum from City Engineer on removing of gas tanks in front of Shell Station at Hub intersection cost to remove and fill approx. \$700.00. Councilman Franchini moves approval to have work done. Councilman Smith seconds same. Passed unanimously

Mayor Little stated he would like permission of council to investigate site for new Fire Station without any commitments. Permission granted.

Mayor Little asked about meeting with Sleepy Hollow Fire District and City Administrator suggested February 27th meeting and will so advise district.
