

MINUTES OF THE REGULAR MEETING OF THE SAN ANSELMO CITY COUNCIL HELD FEBRUARY 27, 1962  
PRESENT COUNCILMEN: Rouse, Smith, Franchini, Reichmuth, Little  
Mayor Little, presiding

Mayor Little welcomed to meeting Nyal Worsham teacher and 8th grade students of Isabel Cook School.

Passed unanimously

ORDINANCE NO. 498 "An ordinance amending the Municipal Code of the City of San Anselmo by adding Chapter 6 to Title 5 thereof, regulating food handling in the City of San Anselmo. Councilman Rouse moves to dispense with further reading. Councilman Smith seconds same. Passed unanimously  
Councilman Smith moves adoption of same. Councilman Reichmuth seconds same. Passed unanimously

Discussion on pedestrian crossing on Redhill & Essex - Installation of lights as recommended by Chief of Police would cost approximately \$2000.00. Councilman Rouse recommends putting sign at Hub "no crossing"  
City Administrator recommends tabling same until Division of Highways comes up with report on signals at Hub. Councilman Smith and Franchini feel signals would defeat purpose in mind of council.  
Councilman Rouse moves approval to plan for signals at Essex as recommended by Chief of Police not to exceed City Engineers estimate of \$2000.00. Councilman Reichmuth seconds same. Motion and second withdrawn  
Council agreed to hire police officer for two hours per day - paint crosswalk for present.

SLEEPY HOLLOW FIRE DISTRICT

Mr. Rogers and Mr. Nannizzi representatives from district present at meeting to discuss with council agreement with city and felt they should not have to share in the cost of alarm system or cost in maintaining San Anselmo hydrants. After lengthy discussion matter was put over for further discussion until the next council meeting.

City Administrator reported on lighting for City Hall area, Dr. Finch will prepare plan and recommendation to council at no extra expense.

Matter of inventory of all City property - City Administrator reported we are prepared to conduct a complete inventory of all property owned by the City, approximately \$800.00 in controller's budget for extra help - Councilman Franchini moves to hire addition help to assist on this inventory, cost not to exceed \$800.00 and also adopt inventory procedure. Councilman Rouse seconds same. Passed unanimously

Matter of extra driveway at 67 Ross Avenue put over for next meeting so council can look at same.

March 20th/set as date for Public Hearing on Zoning Ordinance and Map.

RESOLUTION 899 A resolution listing vacancies to be filled on council, precincts and election officers for General Municipal Election to be held April 10th, 1962. Councilman Rouse moves adoption of above resolution. Councilman Smith seconds same. Passed unanimously

RESOLUTION 900 A resolution accepting deed for parcel #6 from Donald Perry and Esther Perry Greene. Councilman Smith moves adoption. Councilman Franchini seconds same. Passed unanimously

Mayor Little recommended the appointment of Howard McKinley to Civil Defense Committee. Councilman Franchini moves approval to appointment. Councilman Rouse seconds same. Passed unanimously

Chief of Police Letter asking an eligible list be established for Police Officer and Police Sergeants.

RESOLUTION 901 Calling examination for eligible list in the Police Department in the classified service of the City of San Anselmo, as provided for in Ord. 244 of the City of San Anselmo  
Councilman Franchini moves adoption. Councilman Smith seconds same. Passed unanimously

Agreement for improvement of urban thoroughfare system. Councilman Rouse moves to authorize Mayor and City Clerk to sign. Councilman Franchini seconds same. Passed unanimously

Mayor Little set Friday, March 2, 1962 as "get acquainted day", public invited to visit City Hall, Library, meet heads of departments and city officials.

Councilman Smith has reported sign has been installed on Smith Lane.

Councilman Rouse called attention to terms of Ron Hill and Russell Spatz members of Planning Commission, same will expire in April.

Councilman Rouse also spoke on member of planning commission who does not attend meetings and suggests he be asked if he intends to continue as a member.

Councilman Rouse spoke on recreation committee and asked if Federal Funds would be available to city - City Administrator says we can qualify/

Councilman Rouse asked about directional keep right sign at Hub - City Engineer stated same not completed - another sign to go up.

Councilman Reichmuth spoke on amendments to subdivision ordinance and slope policy feels subdivider should share in cost of widening of roads leading into subdivision. City Administrator recommends a study be made for location of future roads, feels this should go to Planning Commission, money in budget to take care of expense for aerial photos. Mr. Leitzell stated he spoke to City Engineer on matter, same would take some time to make study and also need for extra help. Mayor suggests Planning Commission hold special meeting and make study and come up with recommendation.

Mr. White present asked if an assessment district could be set up - council advised him it could but people on Redwood Road would have to initiate same.
