

MINUTES OF THE REGULAR MEETING OF THE SAN ANSELMO CITY COUNCIL HELD MAY 8, 1962
PRESENT COUNCILMEN: Rouse, Smith, Franchini, Capurro, Reichmuth
Mayor Reichmuth, presiding

Councilman Rouse moves approval to minutes of April 17th and 24th. Councilman Smith seconds same. Passed unanimously

Results of successful candidates for position of Fire Lieutenant read as follows:

Joseph DePatta	74.27%
Gerald Cahill	71.25%

Councilman Franchini moves to promulgate list. Councilman Capurro seconds same. Passed unanimously

Recommendation from Fire Chief that Joseph DePatta be promoted to rank of Fire Lieutenant effective May 16, 1962, Range 20 Salary \$556.00. Councilman Franchini moves approval to the appointment. Councilman Smith seconds same. Passed unanimously

Councilman Franchini moves to promulgate list. Councilman Rouse seconds same. Passed unanimously

WILSHIRE OIL CO. letter asking council's approval to install two lighted price signs beneath existing identification sign at 700 Sir Francis Drake Blvd. Letter from Chief of Police having no objections to same. Councilman Smith moves approval to request. Councilman Capurro seconds same. Passed unanimously

MOBIL OIL COMPANY, letter asking council's approval of a 16 ft extension to present existing 30' approach to station located on Sir Francis Drake & Redhill. Memo from City Engineer stating he had inspected same with Chief of Police and recommend driveway not be extended any closer to the curb return. In addition an additional one-way arrow is recommended for installation in the traffic island directly opposite the subject driveway. Councilman Franchini moves to deny request of Mobil Oil Company. Councilman Rouse seconds same. Passed unanimously

PLANNING COMMISSION VACANCY: Mayor Reichmuth recommends Jerry Lloyd to Planning Commission to fill vacancy by resignation of Charles Alfsnes term to expire April 18, 1963. Councilman Rouse moves approval of above appointment. Councilman Franchini seconds same. Passed unanimously

STREET NAME CHANGE: City Engineer recommends that the northerly portion of Hoag Avenue served by Canyon Road be renamed Ivy Lane to correspond to actual use, and that Ivy Lane together with the southerly portion of Hoag Avenue but being extensions of Scenic Avenue be renamed Scenic Avenue. City Attorney suggests setting first meeting in June as Public Hearing on same, clerk to notify all people living on streets.

OAK SPRINGS, UNIT 4, H.W. LASTER ^{Resol 910} Final Map. Councilman Rouse moves map be accepted. Councilman Smith seconds same. Passed unanimously

S-17, FINAL MAP RICHARD WHITE ^{Resol 909} Redwood Road - Councilman Smith moves to accept map. Councilman Rouse seconds same. Passed unanimously

RESOLUTION 907 "Claims and demands for the month of April in the amount of \$51,370.61. Councilman Smith moves approval. Councilman Capurro seconds same. Passed unanimously

AGREEMENT between the City of San Anselmo and Gene Saalwaechter, consultant on Park & Recreation presented by City Attorney. Councilman Smith moves approval and Mayor and City Clerk to sign. Councilman Franchini seconds same. Passed unanimously

LIBRARY BOARD VACANCY, Mayor Reichmuth recommends the appointment of Mrs. Dorothy Linderman, 91 Oak Knoll Avenue to fill vacancy left by death of Grace Cornwall, term to expire June 6, 1963. Councilman Smith moves approval of above appointment. Councilman Franchini seconds same. Passed unanimously

Mayor Reichmuth reported he will attend meeting of Pollution Control in San Rafael.
