

MINUTES OF THE REGULAR MEETING OF THE SAN ANSELMO CITY COUNCIL HELD MAY 22, 1962  
 PRESENT COUNCILMEN: Rouse, Smith, Franchini, Capurro, Reichmuth  
 Mayor Reichmuth, presiding

Eugene Wilson, et al., letter from owners of property located on Island Drive asking council's assistance in helping them find a way to build on their property. Planning Commission turned down rezoning of same, also lot split which did not conform to slope policy. After discussion on matter Mayor Reichmuth suggested matter be taken back to Planning Commission.

Philip J. Anaya, 76 Allyn Avenue letter regarding fence partly constructed in street area. City Administrator reported on fence partly constructed in street area also same is in violation being 6' in height. Mr. Cowan resident of Allyn Avenue spoke to council on matter. Chief of Police had inspected same reported same is in violation. Councilman Rouse also inspected same and feels same should be removed from present place and would like to have recommendation from Chief of Police back at next council meeting. Chief of Police gave verbal recommendation that fence be moved back. Councilman Rouse moves Philip Anaya be directed and ordered to remove fence from city easement, ( 1 week to do so). Councilman Capurro seconds same. Passed unanimously

Association of Bay Area Governments letter inviting city to become a member of their organization, cost \$114.00 for coming year. Councilman Smith not convinced of necessity of joining. City Administrator to write letter city not interested at this time.

1962-63 Budget - dates of June 6th, 7th and 11th at 8:00 p.m., for budget.

Board of Supervisors letter asking city if they are agreeable to appointing a member to the committee authorized by Board to discuss road connecting Terra Linda and San Anselmo. Councilman Rouse feels Board should talk to council as a group not an individual.

Charles Leitzell spoke on meeting he attended representing city.

Councilman Rouse stated he would like letter sent to George Gnos stating we as city not interested in attending meeting but if Board of Supervisors would like to address council they would be welcome.

Mayor Reichmuth stated before joining would like some representative come before council and explain further. Councilman Franchini moves City Administrator represent city. Councilman Smith seconds same. Passed unanimously  
 Mayor Reichmuth read letter from Mr. Salinger on above matter.

City Administrator spoke on special census.

Resolution 908 A resolution authorizing the City Administrator, Mayor and City Clerk to order and contract for an estimate of population by and through the Department of Finance, State of California.

Councilman Rouse moves adoption of resolution, Mayor and City Clerk to sign same. Councilman Smith seconds same. Passed unanimously

Resignation of William Roe as public works director read.

Councilman Rouse moves to accept with regret this resignation as Public Works Director for City to take effect within 60 days from date of resignation and wishing him well in his new assignment. Councilman Franchini seconds same. Passed unanimously

Councilman Rouse moves to authorize City Administrator to prepare immediately for new Public Works director with functions as previously described. Councilman Franchini seconds same. Passed unanimously

City Administrator read letter from John McInnis, chairman City Committee on County Contribution for city streets, asking representative from City at June 18th meeting with Board of Supervisors. City Administrator and Councilman Smith will attend meeting.

City Administrator reported meeting of Mayors and Councilmen will be held May 31st, at Belvedere.

City Administrator reported signal light bar for Bank and Sir Francis Drake would cost approximately \$2,500.00, also reported on Sequoia & Redhill and Chief of Police stated pedestrian's could legally cross same whether marked or not and could see no advantage to moving same back as suggested by Councilman Capurro. City Administrator to get estimate cost on one signal light on pole.

Councilman Franchini moves permission be granted to erect sign at rear of City Hall reserved parking for city business only. Councilman Capurro seconds same. Passed unanimously

Councilman Rouse stated Greyhound property badly in need of cleaning of grass and weeds.

Mr. Metten present at meeting spoke regarding the dangerous condition of Sais Avenue foot bridge stating boards are missing, signs that have been put up by city have been torn down and thrown into creek, something should be done before someone is badly hurt.

Councilman Capurro suggests putting wire and boards across same to close up. City Administrator stated money for same could be brought up at budget time. Councilman Rouse suggests get going on repair of same right away. City Administrator will have plans and specs prepared and bids to be opened at June 12th meeting.

Councilman Franchini advised council he had been contacted by Phil Hiaring and senior baseball will open Saunday at Recreation Park and council members are invited to be present for opening.

Mayor Reichmuth reported Mr. Keller would like to meet with council at his home. City Administrator to ask them to appear at next regular meeting of council.

Meeting adjourned at 10:30 p.m. until June 6th.
