

Minutes of the regular meeting of the San Anselmo City Council held January 23, 1963

PRESENT COUNCILMEN: Smith, Franchini, Capurro, Reichmuth
Mayor Reichmuth, presiding

PETITION from Barber Avenue residents asking council to give consideration to the following: automotive push button signals at Sir Francis Drake & Barber, signal warning signs north and south of the Sir Francis Drake signals. Stop signs on San Anselmo Avenue at Ross - no left turn sign at exit of the parking area adjacent to Ross Valley Savings & Loan, etc.

Chief of Police letter on his department investigating above - Push button signals at Sir Francis Drake & Barber not in order, but suggesting overhead signals be eliminated and four standard signal posts erected. Signal warnings have been there for some time. Arterial stop signs on San Anselmo Ave at Ross not in order - stop sign at the exit of parking lot in order but does not favor a No Left Turn sign at this location.

Freeman Andrews, 30 Prospect Avenue acted as spokesman for petitions and gave an estimate for (4) signals posts at Sir Francis Drake & Barber. Councilman Smith moves police officer be stationed at San Anselmo & Ross Avenues between 8 & 9 and 3 & 4 for school children and City Administrator to pursue estimate as given by Mr. Andrews and also study traffic problems for schools. Councilman Franchini seconds same. Passed unanimously

Yolansdale School PTA representatives present regarding traffic problems and need for traffic control at the school area. Chief of Police letter making recommendations for painting pedestrian crossings. City Administrator to investigate further and report back to council.

DOWNTOWN CENTER PLAN REPORT:

Art Kaufmann reported on Downtown Center Plan and asked council for authorization and money to proceed with first stage of program.

Councilman Franchini moves to authorize \$2500.00 to carry on stage No. 1 of Downtown Center Plan and transfer money from General Fund. Councilman Smith seconds same. Passed unanimously

RESOLUTION 238 "Accepting the improvements of Forbes Avenue in Burchwood Park, and Jordan Avenue from Hilldale to Forbes for maintenance.

Councilman Smith moves adoption of same. Councilman Capurro seconds. Passed unan.

Councilman Franchini moves approval of \$8,067.46 payable to County for the improvement of Sir Francis Drake Blvd. Councilman Smith seconds same. Passed unan.

Due to February 12th being a holiday, council will meet on the 5th, clerk to put notice on bulletin board.

Mayor Reichmuth recommends the following to Recreation Commission.

Planning Commissions recommendations on amendments to zoning ordinance referred to City Attorney.

Ordinance 486 "An ordinance amending ordinance No. 485 of the City of San Anselmo by changing the property classification from first residential (R-1) to multiple (R3) zone, being Lots 2,3,4,5 & 6, Sequoia Park No. 1 property of Clyde Bldg. Assoc. Inc. Read in Full

Ordinance 490 "An ordinance Adopting the 1962 National Electrical Code. February 26th set as date for public hearing on adoption of same.

Matter of appointment of councilman to replace Robert Rouse, resigned.

Mayor stated following names have been suggested: Laurie Antolini, Cedric Clute, Charles Leitzell, Richard Hartshorne and Homer Crowell.

Mayor Reichmuth moves Cedric Clute be appointed to fill vacancy. Councilman Franchini seconds same.

Councilman Capurro moves Laurie Antolini be appointed. Councilman Smith seconds same.

Councilman Franchini moves nominations be closed.

Mayor Reichmuth called special meeting for Friday January 25, 1963 on above.

City Administrator asked authorization to purchase steam cleaner for \$821.00
Councilman Franchini moves approval to purchase same. Councilman Capurro seconds same. Passed unanimously
