

Minutes of the regular meeting of the San Anselmo City Council held on February 25th 1964.

Present Councilman: Clute, Capurro, Reichmuth, Franchini, Smith
Mayor Smith, presiding

Drainage Problem - H. Johnson, The Alameda

City Administrator reported Mr. Johnson is willing to make an opening in pipe for water to drain off, City Engineer would like to make a further study and Administrator asked council to put matter off for two weeks. Mr. Johnson asked council to lift stop work order so men can go ahead with work. City Administrator asked if plans are OK would council give approval to lift stop work order.

Councilman Franchini moves City Administration be given discretion to lift stop work order if plans meet the approval of the City Engineer.

Councilman Clute seconds same. Passed unanimously

Loma Robles Subdivision:

Revision of final map, this map was approved by the Planning Commission in revised form and they recommended that council approve same.

Councilman Clute moves approval of revised final map of Loma Robles Subdivision. Councilman Capurro seconds same. Passed unanimously

Russ Duranto:

City Attorney reported on problem of Russ Duranto and read Sec. 1954 of the Government Code - stating that hiring Russ Duranto to do janitorial work and knowing the condition of his eyes, in case of accident to himself or anyone else council and city could be held liable.

Councilman Capurro feels Russ belongs in the Street Department and should be kept there, either pulling weeds, working in park, etc. but feels janitorial work would be a greater hazard, City could create a new position and keep him working for Street Department.

Councilman Clute would like to have competent medical advice to find out his physical condition. Councilman Reichmuth feels no doctor would stick out his neck but feels City Administrator could get opinion of another eye doctor.

Councilman Franchini moves by next meeting City Administrator get written report from another eye doctor (Dr. McBain). Councilman Clute seconds same. Passed unanimously

Officer for crosswalk:

Chief of Police recommended Ed. Terrell, Bungalow Ave. San Rafael be appointed crossing guard @ \$100.00 per month plus \$80.00 for uniform. Starting March 2, 1964.

Councilman Reichmuth moves approval as recommended by Chief. Councilman Franchini seconds same. Passed unanimously

City Administrator feels this is a position for a younger man but will try it out, also he is making a study on same and will present to council at a later date.

Councilman Franchini moves approval to purchase surplus truck for \$150.00 and transfer amount from general fund. Councilman Clute seconds same. Passed unanimously

Letter from County Administrators office regarding animal control ordinance and agreement. City Administrator stated county would like city to revise dog ordinance to comply with county in (3) respects - graduated fees for quarantine, graduated fee for impounding and raise license fee from \$3.00 to \$4.00 and county would upgade their patrolling. Councilman Franchini moves council agree to go along with above. Councilman Reichmuth seconds same. Passed unanimously

Ordinance No. 510 "An ordinance amending ordinance 398 commonly known as the "Fire Zone Ordinance" by changing certain real property from Fire Zone 2 to Fire Zone 1, and from Fire Zone 1 and 3 to Fire Zone 2. (Gilroy property)
First reading.

Ordinance No. 509 "An ordinance amending section 10-3.1906 (f) (2) by providing that cornices, eaves, and canopies may extend not more than two (2) feet into side yards. First reading.

Resolution No. 995A a resolution accepting into the San Anselmo Public Street system a certain portion of Kenrick Drive. Councilman Reichmuth moves adoption. Councilman Capurro seconds same. Passed unanimously

Resolution No. 996 A resolution restricting parking of trucks or buses on a portion of the former Railroad right of way now known as Sir Francis Drake Blvd. South. Councilman Franchini moves adoption. Councilman Reichmuth seconds same. Passed unanimously

Resolution No. 997 Listing vacancies to be filled, voting precincts, election officers for the April 14th election. Councilman Reichmuth moves adoption. Councilman Clute

Council complimented Chief on recent capture of (2) men by two city Police Officers.
