

Minutes of the regular meeting of the San Anselmo City Council held on June 27, 1967.

Present Councilmen: Scott, Capurro, Ragan, Reichmuth, Smith
Mayor Smith, Presiding

Mayor Smith spoke on displaying the flag and read letter from Congress Don Clausen regarding same.

Matter of tree at 66 Tamalpais Ave. Councilman Ragan stated he inspected same and feels should be handled same as Sousa's tree, same should be removed. City Engineer did not consider public hazard-tree roots could be cut out, approx cost to remove \$200 to \$300.00

M/S Councilman Capurro-Ragan city break out concrete, take out tree roots and Mr. Marchisio owner of property will finish sidewalk. Passed unanimously

APPEAL, D. G. McClelland, 147 Humboldt Avenue regarding demolition of old garage.

Councilman Ragan feels garage is unsafe, Planning Commission denied this appeal and he would not overrule their decision. City Engineer stated inside garage is OK, outside very bad condition, could not park car there in present condition. Councilman Capurro inspected garage, feels could be put in condition and he has no objections to same being used as storage area-Mayor Smith also inspected, stated he has seen other garages in worse condition-approach to same needs repairs, feels with a little repair work same could be used. Councilman Ragan moves appeal of Mr. McClelland be denied. Motion failed for want of second.

M/S Councilman Capurro-Scott appeal of Mr. McClelland be approved with 12 ft. encroachment, grant 6 month period to put same in condition. Motion passed on following vote:

M/S Councilman Capurro-Scott approval to 15' variance for car-deck at 147 Humboldt Avenue. Passed unanimously

M/S Councilman Reichmuth-Ragan approval to display car in Shopping Area. Passed unanimously

Recommendation of Advisory Committee that downtown parking be changed to 2 hours. City Administrator suggest contacting merchants for their opinion. Councilman Capurro suggest holding over for 30 days and give Chamber of Commerce and merchants chance to be heard-feels this should be done on a six month basis -Police Chief could give a report on number of tickets issued on San Anselmo Avenue. Jim Reed stated council should consider other recommendations made by committee at same time.

M/S Councilman Ragan-Capurro that a public hearing on matter of two hour parking be held at council meeting of July 25. Passed unanimously

M/S Councilman Scott-Ragan approval to contract for 60th Anniversary and Mayor to sign same. Passed unanimously M/S Councilman Ragan-Scott set up \$2000.00 revolving fund. Passed unanimously

Budget-1967-68 M/S Councilman Reichmuth-Ragan same be approved. Passed unanimously Councilman Scott asked City Attorney to check into matter of salaries for councilmen.

Councilman Reichmuth asked that same be put on agenda for next meeting. He would like to see matter of salaries put on ballot at next election.

Business License discussion-Mayor Smith and City Attorney stated this is what the merchants wanted when public hearings were held-Mr. Fischel spoke against present business license ordinance. Councilman Reichmuth stated he would not want to change any part of ordinance until he has gone into same further.

M/S Councilman Scott-Capurro that business license ordinance remain as is. Passed unanimously

City Administrator spoke on Sec 6-1-09 relating to initial payment on retail sales. Same will be brought up at next meeting.

Council will meet with Fairfax City Council on July 13th.

Resolution No. 1153 Calling for examination for police-clerk dispatcher.

M/S Councilman Reichmuth-Scott same be adopted. Passed unanimously

M/S Councilman Scott-Ragan approval to request from Frank Quinn to purchase lawn mower for \$150.00. Passed unanimously

M/S Councilman Scott-Ragan approval to purchase calculator \$300.00. Passed unanimously

Resolution No. 1154 accepting deed from Marus & Margareth Larsen, Vine Street. M/S Councilman Ragan-Scott approval of same. Passed unanimously

Letter from Engineer's office which is being sent to all property owners in Morningside Court are regarding street lights read. City Engineer asked council to look at new lights on Fern Lane.

Chamber of Commerce letter with reference to budget request listing breakdown, total figure of \$3500.00, not including \$1500.00 for brochures. Councilman Scott stated he is in favor of \$3500.00 but would rather see \$600. Listed for Congress for Community Progress put into brochures, Councilman Capurro feels the same-City Attorney will have ordinance ready for next meeting. M/S Councilman Ragan-Scott approval of \$1500.00 for brochure from general fund. Motion passed on following vote:

City Attorney reported trial of City/NWPP will start July 10th.

Councilman Scott said people have asked about doing a minimum amount of work at Sorich property-would like to put this matter on agenda for next meeting.

Mayor Smith read letter from Calif.State Auto Assoc. commending city on no Fatalities in past year- also read letter from Calif. Roadside Council.

James Reed spoke about special meeting- date for same set for August 1, 1967.

Councilman Adjourned at 10:45 P.M. to meet in executive session.
