

Ordinance No. 22

"Relating to street work and the removal of gravel and other surface dressing from the streets."

The Board of Trustees of the Town of San Anselmo do ordain as follows: ---

- Section 1 No person, firm or corporation shall contract for or do any work upon the streets or sidewalks of the Town of San Anselmo until permission in writing is first obtained from the Board of Trustees of said Town.
- Section 2 When required by the Board of Trustees, the person, firm or corporation doing work upon the streets or sidewalks shall file with the clerk of said Town a good and sufficient bond with at least two sureties to be approved by the President of the Board of Trustees and made payable to the Board of Trustees for such sum as the Board may direct, conditioned upon the faithful performance of the work.
- Section 3 No person, firm or corporation shall, in the Town of San Anselmo, tear up, loosen or remove any portion of the macadam, gravel or other surface dressing, or the surface of any public street, without giving written notice thereof to the Street Committee of the Board of Trustees and depositing with the Town clerk of said Town the sum of Two (\$20.00) Dollars for each thirty square feet, or portion thereof, to be so torn up, loosened or removed, as security for any damage that may be caused thereby, and that the street will be left in as good condition as it was before being so torn up, loosened or disturbed and that the Town and Trustees

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shall be held harmless from all claims of whatever kind or nature, for damages or otherwise, arising in any way from said tearing up, loosening or removal, or the excavations resulting therefrom.

Section

4 All such work shall be done under the supervision and to the satisfaction of the Street Committee of the Board of Trustees, and the material taken up or removed shall be replaced in accordance with the specifications for just macadamizing or gravelling the street, if any, and in all cases as may be required from time to time by the Board of Trustees; and the filling of trenches shall be thoroughly tamped and wet down. The surface dressing shall be rolled or tamped so as to leave no ridge in the street. The person, firm or corporation so removing the surface dressing or surface shall, at any time within one year after replacing the same, on demand of the Town Marshall or the Street Committee, repeat said work of replacing the surface, and do all filling that may be necessary to raise any sunken part of the street to the proper grade.

Section

5 Upon the completion of any of the work above mentioned, the Town Marshall shall inspect the same, and if the street remains in good condition for one year after said inspection by the Town Marshall, he shall so certify to the Town Clerk, who shall thereupon return the deposit made. In the event of said material not being properly replaced and the street left in such order and condition as may be required by the Town Marshall or the Trustees, the Town Marshall or the Trustees may cause the same to be repaired and certify the cost to the Town Clerk, who shall deduct such amount from the sum so deposited, and set out the balance, if any.

Section 6

In lieu of said cash deposit, a bond in double the amount required for said deposit, with two good and sufficient sureties approved by the President of the Board of Trustees, and made payable to the Board of Trustees, may be filed with the Clerk. Said bond must be conditioned upon said roadway being left in such condition as may be required by the Town Marshal and the Town Trustees, and that the Town Trustees shall be held harmless from all claims, of whatsoever kind and nature, for damages or otherwise, arising in any way from said tearing up, loosening or removal, or excavation resulting from the same.

Section 7

Any person violating the provisions of this Ordinance shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor, and upon conviction thereof shall be punished by a fine of not less than Ten or more than Three Hundred Dollars, or by imprisonment not exceeding ninety days or by both such fine and imprisonment.
