Ordinance #24

"Relating to the maintaining of
Garbage Cans for the deposit of Garbage"

The Board of Trustees of the Town
of San Anselmo do ordain as follows -

Section I - No garbage or any dead animal, or
any putrid or offensive animal or vegetable
matter, shall be allowed to remain upon
the premises of any person or deposited
upon any street, or vacant lot, or creek,
or in any standing water or excavation
within the Town limits.

Section II Every person shall maintain upon his
premises whether an owner or lessee, resident
or camper, a galvanized iron garbage can
for the deposit of garbage or other waste
matter and shall keep the same covered
and shall cause same to be emptied at
least once every week.

Section III Every person who shall violate any
of the provisions of this ordinance shall
be guilty of a misdemeanor, and upon
conviction thereof shall be punished by
a fine not exceeding one hundred dollars
(\$100.00), or by an imprisonment for a
period not exceeding thirty (30) days.

This ordinance shall take effect immediately.
