

Ordinance # 32

"Amending Ordinance #26 of the Board of Trustees of the Town of San Anselmo"

The Board of Trustees of the Town of San Anselmo do ordain as follows.

Section 1 Section 1 of Ordinance #26 of the Board of Trustees is hereby amended to read as follows:-

On the last Monday of November of each year at six o'clock P.M., all taxes then unpaid are delinquent and thereafter the Tax Collector must collect for the use of the Town an addition of ten per cent thereon. All taxes on all personal property unsecured by real property shall be due and payable immediately after the assessment of said personal property is made.

Section 2 This Ordinance shall be in full and effect from and after the date of its passage.
