

Ordinance # 33

Relating to the Removal of Grass
and Weeds from Sidewalks and Quaternways

The Board of Trustees of the Town
of San Anselmo do ordain as follows:-

Section 1 Every person, firm, or corporation occupy
any, or having charge or control of, any
lot, property, or premises, shall remove
all grass, weeds and other shrubbery from
the sidewalk space in front of it, or at the
said property, or premises, and from the
quaternways in front of the same, and all
other substances and things which shall
obstruct the free flow of water in said
quaternways.

Section 2 Any person, firm, or corporation, violat
any of the provisions of this Ordinance,
shall be deemed guilty of misdemeanor
and, upon conviction thereof, shall be
punished by a fine not exceeding three
hundred dollars (\$100.00), or by imprisonment
for not more than thirty (30) days.

Section 3 This Ordinance shall be in force
and effect from and after the date of
its passage.
