

- Ordinance #40 -

"An Order Prohibiting the Damming or
Empounding of Waters of Creeks or Streams."

The Board of Trustees of the Town
of San Anselmo, County of Marin, State
of California, do order, as follows:

Section 1. It is hereby declared to be unlawful
for any person, or persons, firm,
co-partnership, or corporation, to dam
or empound any water or waters flowing
in any creek or stream, in the Town of
San Anselmo.

Section 2. Any person, or persons, firm,
co-partnership, or corporation, violating
any of the provisions of this Ordinance
shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor,
and, upon conviction thereof, shall
be punished by a fine of not exceeding
Fifty Dollars, or by imprisonment not to
exceed Twenty-five days, or by both such
fine and imprisonment.

Section 3. All Ordinances, and parts of
Ordinances, in conflict herewith, are
hereby repealed.

Section 4. This Ordinance shall take effect
and be in full force immediately after
its passage and adoption.

The above and foregoing Ordinance
was duly adopted and passed
by the Board of Trustees of the Town of
