

ORDINANCE NO. 47

AN ORDINANCE DIVIDING THE TERRITORY OF THE TOWN OF  
SAN ANSELMO INTO TWO (2) SEWER DISTRICTS, TO BE  
KNOWN AS SEWER DISTRICT NO. 1 AND SEWER DISTRICT  
NO. 2.

The Board of Trustees of the Town of San Anselmo do ordain as follows:

Section 1. The territory of the Town of San Anselmo is hereby divided into Two (2) sewer districts, to be known as Sewer District No. 1 and Sewer District No. 2.

Section 2. The territory of Sewer District No. 1 is hereby fixed and particularly described as follows, to-wit:

All that certain tract of land, situate, lying and being in the Town of San Anselmo, County of Marin, State of California, and bounded as follows, to-wit:

Beginning at the intersection of the Northerly line of the tract of land conveyed by John O. B. Short, et al, to The San Francisco Presbyterian Orphanage and Farm, a corporation, by deed recorded in Liber "52" of Deeds, page 21, Marin County Records, with the boundary line between the Rancho San Pedro Santa Margarita y Las Gallinas and the Canada de Herrera; thence North  $11^{\circ} 15'$  East along said boundary line 22.50 chains to the Northerly line of the Town of San Anselmo; thence leaving said boundary line and along said Northerly line of the Town of San Anselmo and crossing and subdividing the tract of land which was conveyed by Cozens to John O. B. Short and Jacob Short by a deed dated APRIL 23, 1899, and recorded in the office of said Recorder in Liber "6" of Deeds at page 252, North  $51^{\circ}$  West 52.50 chains, a little more or less.



*Let a line be run*

said Rancho Canada de Herrera and the said Rancho Punta de Quezting  
thence Easterly along the said boundary line to the center line  
of the surveye San Anselmo; thence Northerly and Westerly along the  
said center line to the Southwest corner of the land of James I.  
Taylor; thence Northerly along the said James I. Taylor lands to  
the Northwest corner thereof; thence Easterly in a straight line  
to the Northwest corner of the lands of San Francisco Presbytarian  
Orphanage and Farm, above referred to; thence Easterly along the  
Northerly line thereof to the point of beginning.

Section 1. The territory of sewer District No. 2 is  
hereby fixed, determined and described, as follows, to-wit:

All the territory not included within sewer  
District No. 1, and lying within the corporate limits of the Town  
of San Anselmo.

Section 4. This ordinance shall take effect immediately  
from and after its passage.
