ORDINAROR NO. 51

AN ORDINANCE TO PROVIDE FOR THE LITERSING OF BUSINESS CARRIED ON IN THE TOTAL OF SAID BUSINESS.

The Board of Trustees of the Town of san Amselmo do ordein as follows:

It shall be unlewful for any person, persons, section 1. association or corporation, whether as principal, officer, clerk, servant, agent, or employee, either for the macives, or any person, persons, association, or corporation, or otherwise, to engage in, conduct, or carry on, any business, exhibition, trade, occupation, or calling, in the Ordinanse specified, without having first procured a license from said fown so to do, as prowided in this Ordinance, and if any such person, persons, association, or corporation, either as principal, officer, clerk, servant, agent, or employee, shall engage in, conduct, or carry on, any such business, exhibition, trade, occupation, or calling, hereinafter mentioned, without first having procured such license, shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeaner, and upon conviction thereof, shall be punished by a fine of not less than Five Dollars (\$5.00), or more than Three hundred Dollars (\$300.00), or by imprisonment for a term not exceeding three months, or by both such fine and imprisonment.

Section 2. Licenses may be issued for the term of three, six, nine or twelve months, and for such other terms as may be required by this article.

section 3. That the rate of license for the business, trade, occupation, or calling, hereinafter named, be, and the same are hereby, established within the Town of San Anselmo, and the same shall be paid by the owners or proprietors thereof, or the person liable therefor, as follows, that is to say:

a common carrier in expressing, transmitting or conveying gold dust, bers, bullion, gold, on general, or any, marchandise,

goods, or housegold furniture, in or to any place within the Town of San Angelmo, shall be deemed an express agent, and shall pay a license of Twenty-five Dollars (\$25.00) per quarter year.

- (b) Every person, firm or corporation owning or operating any railroad propalled by steam or electric power, or other motive power, within the Town of San Anseled, shall pay a license of Twenty-five Dollars (\$25.00) per quarter year.
- Every person, firm or corporation engaged in the business of supplying gas or electric light, or electric power, or any also trie service, to or for the inhabitants of the Town of San Arselm, shall pay a license of Twenty-five Dallens (\$25.00) per quarter year.
- Every person, firm or corperation engaged in: (d) the business of supplying water to or for the imhabitants of the Yown of San Anselm, shall pay a license of Twenty-five Dollars (\$25.00) per quarter year.
- Every person, firm or corporation engaged in (0) the business of supplying telephone service to or for the intellatants of the Town of San Anselm, shall pay a license of Twentyfive Dollars (\$25.00) per quarter year.
- Every person, fire or corporation engaged in (f) the business of receiving and transmitting telegraphic messages, over telegraph wires, within the Town of San Anselm, shall pay a license of Twenty-five Bollars (\$35.00) per quarter year.

This Ordinance chall take offect and be in section 4. force impodiately.
