

Ordinance # 52

CHANGING PLACE OF REGULAR MONTHLY MEETINGS
OF THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES.

The Board of Trustees of the Town of San Anselmo
do ordain as follows:

Section 1. The regular monthly meetings of the Board of Trustees shall be held on the second Thursday of every month at the Crocker Building on the northerly line of Ross Avenue, distant about two hundred and thirty (230) feet westerly from the westerly line of the right of way of the Northwestern Pacific Railroad Company, in said Town of San Anselmo.

Section 2. All Ordinances, and parts of Ordinances, in conflict herewith, are expressly repealed.

Section 3. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force immediately.
