

REGULATING THE ESTABLISHMENT AND MAINTENANCE  
OF HOSPITALS.

The Board of Trustees of the Town of San Anselmo do ordain as follows:

Section 1. It shall be unlawful for any person, firm, corporation or association to erect, establish or maintain any hospital without permission from the Board of Trustees.

Section 2. Any person, firm, corporation or association who shall violate any of the provisions of this Ordinance shall be guilty of a misdemeanor, and, upon conviction thereof, shall be punished by a fine not exceeding One hundred Dollars (\$100.00) or by imprisonment for not more than Three (3) months, or by both such fine and imprisonment.

Section 3. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force immediately.
