

REGULATING THE DEPOSIT OF RUBBISH AND OTHER INFLAMMABLE MATERIAL AND ASHES, PROHIBITING THE LIGHTING OF FIRES UPON THE PUBLIC STREETS AND VACANT LOTS, PROVIDING FOR THE REMOVAL OF RUBBISH AND OTHER USELESS MATERIALS AFTER FIRE, PROHIBITING DRIVING OVER THE FIRE HOSE, PROHIBITING THE INTERFERENCE OF THE FIRE ALARM SYSTEM, AND THE MAKING OR GIVING OF FALSE ALARMS OF FIRE, IN THE TOWN OF SAN ANSELMO.

The Board of Trustees of the Town of San Anselmo do ordain as follows:

Section 1: Every person in the Town of San Anselmo making, using, or having the charge or control of shavings, hay, straw, sacks, bags, litter, or any other combustible waste, or fragments, shall, at the close of each day, cause the same to be securely stored or disposed of, so as to be safe from fire.

All receptacles for waste, rags, paper, rubbish, and other substance liable by spontaneous combustion, or otherwise, to cause fire, must be made of inflammable material, and all said receptacles shall be kept in such a place that were the contents of said receptacle to ignite the same may be easily seen and removed.

No explosive or inflammable compound, or combustible material of any kind, shall be kept, stored or placed under any stairway of any building, or under any building, or used in such place or manner as to obstruct and render egress hazardous in case of fire.

Section 2: It shall be unlawful for any person, or persons, to deposit any ashes, or cause the same to be deposited or placed, or to permit or suffer the same to be or remain in any wooden vessel or receptacle, composed or made of combustible material, but said ashes shall be placed and kept in some safe depository and receptacle of galvanized iron or other combustible material, and not less than two (2) inches from any wood work or structure.

Section 3: It shall be unlawful for any person to kindle or light, or cause to be kindled or lighted, any bon fire on any public highway, unless a written permit has been obtained from the President of the Board of Trustees so to do.

Section 4: It shall be unlawful for any person to kindle or light, or cause to be kindled or lighted, any bon fire on any vacant lot, unless the owner or leasee of said vacant lot has first obtained from the Town Marshall of the Town of San Anselmo a written permission so to do.

Section 5: The owner or person having in his possession, or under his control, on any premises, any hay, straw, or forage of any kind, paper, or other substance, which has been rendered useless, or unmerchantable, by reason of any fire on said premises, or any other debris resulting from such fire, must remove the same from such premises within twenty-four (24) hours after notice so to do from the Town Marshall of the Town of San Anselmo.

Section 6: No person, or persons, shall drive over with any vehicle, or conveyance of freight or passengers, any line of hose in use by, or belonging to, the Fire Department, of the Town of San Anselmo.

Section 7: It shall be unlawful for any person, and or corporation to place, or cause to be placed, any article or thing on or upon any sidewalk in such a manner as to interfere with the free access or approach to any signal box of the fire system, or to break, remove, or injure, or cause to be broken, removed, or injured, any of the parts or appurtenances of said system, or without authority to make or fit, or cause to be made or fitted, any key to the lock of any signal box of said system, or without authority to have or retain in his possession any key belonging to, or fitted to, the lock of any such signal box, or to pick or force the lock of any such signal box.

Section 8: It is hereby unlawful for any person wilfully to make, or cause to be made, any false alarm of fire by means of the town, or any telegraph, or telephone system, or any other way.

Section 9: Any person, firm, or corporation, who shall violate any of the provisions of this Ordinance, shall be guilty of a misdemeanor, and, upon conviction thereof, shall be punished by a fine not exceeding Three hundred Dollars (\$300.00), or by imprisonment in the County Jail for a period not exceeding Three (3) months, or by both such fine and imprisonment.

Section 10: All Ordinances, and parts of Ordinances, in conflict herewith, are hereby expressly repealed.

Section 11: This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

to kindle or light, or cause to be kindled or lighted, any bon fire on any vacant lot, unless the owner or lessee of said vacant lot has first obtained from the ~~President of the Board of Trustees~~ ^{Town Marshal of the Town of San Anselmo} a written permission as to do.

Section 5: The owner or person having in his possession, or under his control, on any premises, any hay, straw, or forage of any kind, paper, or other substance, which has been rendered useless, or unmerchantable, by reason of any fire on said premises, or any other debris resulting from such fire, must remove the same from such premises within twenty-four (24) hours after notice so to do from the ~~President of the Board of Trustees~~ ^{Town Marshal} of the Town of San Anselmo.

Section 6: No person, or persons, shall drive over with any vehicle, or conveyance of freight or passengers, any line of hose in use by, or belonging to, the Fire Department, or the Town of San Anselmo.

Section 7: It shall be unlawful for any person, firm or corporation to place, or cause to be placed, any article or thing on or upon any sidewalk in such a manner as to interfere with the free access or approach to any signal box of the fire system, or to break, remove, or injure, or cause to be broken, removed, or injured, any of the parts or appurtenances of said system, or without authority to make or fit, or cause to be made or fitted, any key to the lock of any signal box of said system, or without authority to have or retain in his possession any key belonging to, or fitted to, the lock of any such signal box, or to pick or force the lock of any such signal box.

Section 8: It is hereby unlawful for any person wilfully to make, or cause to be made, any false alarm of fire by means of the town, or any telegraph, or telephone system, or any other way.

Section 9: Any person, firm, or corporation, who shall violate any of the provisions of this Ordinance, shall be guilty of a misdemeanor, and, upon conviction thereof, shall be punished by a fine not exceeding Three hundred Dollars (\$300.00), or by imprisonment in the County Jail for a period not exceeding

three (3) months, or by both such fine and imprisonment.

Section 10: All Ordinances, and parts of Ordinances, in conflict herewith, are hereby expressly repealed.

Section 11: This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
