

ORDINANCE NO. 110

PROHIBITING PERSONS UNDER EIGHTEEN YEARS OF AGE FROM BEING ON THE STREETS, ALLEYS AND PUBLIC PLACES IN THE TOWN OF SAN ANSELMO, AT NIGHT AFTER THE HOUR OF NINE O'CLOCK P. M. AND SUNRISE.

The Board of Trustees of the Town of San Anselmo do ordain as follows:

Section 1. It is hereby made unlawful for any person under eighteen years of age to be or remain in or upon any of the streets, alleys or public places in the Town of San Anselmo, at night, after the hour of nine o'clock p. m. and sunrise, unless such person is accompanied by a parent, the guardian or other persons having legal custody of such minor person, or whose employment makes it necessary to be upon such streets, alleys or public places during the nighttime after the hour specified. In the event such minor person after the hour specified shall be in or upon any of the streets, alleys or public places in performance of an errand of duty and directed by his or her parent, guardian or other person having the care and custody of such minor person, or shall be upon any of the streets, alleys or public places, then such minor shall provide himself or herself with a written permission for the purpose, signed by his or her parent, guardian or other person having the care and custody of such minor person.

Section 2. It is hereby made unlawful for any parent, guardian or other person having the legal care and custody of a person under eighteen years of age to allow or permit such minor to go or be in or upon any of the public streets, alleys or public places in the Town of San Anselmo within the time prohibited in Section One of this Ordinance, unless there exists a reasonable necessity therefor, or unless the employment of such minor makes it necessary for him or her to be upon such streets, alleys or public places within the time prohibited in Section One of this Ordinance.

Section 3. Any person violating the provisions of Sections One or Two of this Ordinance shall, upon conviction, be fined in a sum not less than five dollars nor more than twenty dollars for each offense, and in the event such fine shall not be paid...

ORDINANCE NO. 110

Section 1. In the event such minor person after the hour specified shall be in or upon any of the streets, alleys or public places in performance of an errand of duty and directed by his or her parent, guardian or other person having the care and custody of such minor person, or shall be upon any of the streets, alleys or public places, then such minor shall provide himself or herself with a written permission for the purpose, signed by his or her parent, guardian or other person having the care and custody of such minor person.

Section 2. It is hereby made unlawful for any parent, guardian or other person having the legal care and custody of a person under eighteen years of age to allow or permit such minor to be or remain in or upon any of the public streets, alleys or public places in the Town of San Anselmo within the time prohibited in Section One of this Ordinance, unless there exists a reasonable necessity therefor, or unless the employment of such minor makes it necessary for him or her to be upon such streets, alleys or public places within the time prohibited in Section One of this Ordinance.

Section 3. Any person violating the provisions of Sections One or Two of this Ordinance shall, upon conviction, be fined a sum not less than five dollars nor more than twenty dollars for each offense, and in the event such fine shall not be paid...

be imprisoned in the Town Prison or County Jail at the rate of one day for every two dollars of such fine.

Section 4. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force thirty (30) days from and after its final passage, approval and publication.

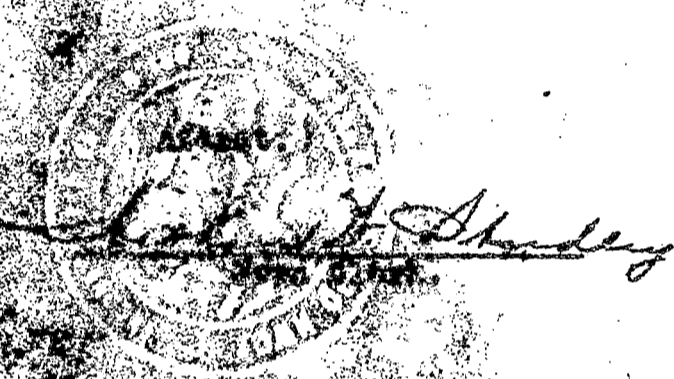
