

ORDINANCE NO. 118

ESTABLISHING THE GRADE OF A PORTION OF  
TUNSTEAD AVENUE.

The Board of Trustees of the Town of San Anselmo do

ordain as follows:

Section 1.- The official Curb Grade of Tunstead Avenue between Cedar Street and a point 450. feet west of San Anselmo Avenue is hereby established in accordance with the following elevations:

At the intersection of the center lines of Cedar Street and Tunstead Avenue, the elevation of Sub-grade shall be 48.5 feet above the official base. On Tunstead Avenue 300. feet Easterly from the Easterly line of Cedar Street, the elevation of Sub-grade shall be 48.0 feet above the official base. On Tunstead Avenue 450. feet west from the westerly line of San Anselmo Avenue, the elevation of Sub-grade shall be 48.3 feet above the official base.

True grade lines shall connect the above points.

Section 2.- The Board of Trustees hereby declares that the immediate preservation of the public health and safety requires that a portion of a certain street of the Town of San Anselmo, to-wit: Tunstead Avenue, be improved by the construction of a concrete culvert across it without delay, and that the passage of this ordinance is a condition precedent to the commencement of proceedings therefor; that, therefor this ordinance is declared to be and is an urgency measure as defined by the act of the Legislature entitled "An Act to provide for direct Legislation by Cities and Towns, including initiative and referendum", approved January 2nd, 1912 and is therefore not subject to the referendum provisions of said act.

Section 3.- This ordinance shall take effect immediately.

Passed and adopted this 9th day of March, 1914 by the following vote:
