

Ordinance No. 122

REPEALING ORDINANCES NOS. 61 AND 114

The Board of Trustees of the Town of San Anselmo do ordain as follows:-

Section 2.- This Ordinance shall take effect and be in full force from and after the 31st day of December, 1914.
