

AN ORDINANCE CREATING AND ESTABLISHING
FIRE ZONES IN THE TOWN OF SAN ANSELMO.

Be it ordained by the City Council and Board of Trustees of the Town of San Anselmo as follows:

Section 1. For the purpose of creating and establishing fire zones in the Town of San Anselmo the territory within said Town is hereby divided into four zones, each of which zones is hereby created and established as, and declared to be, a Fire Zone, said four zones to be known respectively as Fire Zone No. 1, Fire Zone No. 2, Fire Zone No. 3 and Fire Zone No. 4; and the territory within said four zones, comprising collectively the entire territory of the Town of San Anselmo shall constitute a Fire District.

Section 2. The boundaries of said four fire zones shall be respectively as follows:

Fire Zone No. 1 shall include such territory or portions of said Town as are included within the following boundaries, to-wit:

COMMENCING at the intersection of the western line of San Anselmo Avenue and the northern line of Belle Avenue and running thence northerly along the western line of San Anselmo Avenue to the Southern line of Ross Avenue; thence northeasterly in a straight line to the intersection of the eastern line of Main Street and the northern line of Barber Avenue; thence easterly along the northern line of Barber Avenue to the western line of Lot 9 of the Barber Tract as shown on the map of said Tract recorded at page 3 of Volume 2 of Maps in the office of the County Recorder of Marin County, California; thence northerly along the said western line of

Lot 9 to the northern line of the said Barber Tract; thence southwesterly along the said northern line of said Barber Tract to the southeast corner of Lot 36 of the Osgood Tract as shown on the map of said Tract recorded at page 61 of Volume 3 of Maps in the Office of said County Recorder; thence northerly along the eastern line of said Osgood Tract to a point thereon one hundred and Twenty-five (125) feet northerly from the northern line of Bank Street; thence northeasterly in a straight line to a point on the western line of Lincoln Avenue, distant thereon seventy-one (71) feet southerly from the southern line of Greenfield Avenue; thence northerly seventy-one (71) feet along the westerly line of Lincoln Avenue to its intersection with the southerly line of Greenfield Avenue; thence westerly along the southern line of Greenfield Avenue to the eastern line of Main Street; thence westerly in a straight line to the intersection of the western line of San Anselmo Avenue and the southern line of Tamalpais Avenue; thence westerly along the southern line of Tamalpais Avenue to the northwest corner of Lot 3 of Ross Valley Park Subdivision 1 as shown on the map of said Subdivision recorded at page 115 of Volume 1 of maps in the office of said County Recorder; thence at right angles southerly in a straight line to the southern line of City Hall Avenue; thence westerly along the southern line of City Hall Avenue to the North East corner of Lot 6 Linda Vista Tract as per map of said Tract on file in the office of the County Recorder of Marin County; thence at right angles southerly along the eastern line of said Lot 6, Linda Vista Tract to a point on said eastern line distant thereon

seventy-five (75) feet from the northern line of Tunstead Avenue; thence westerly in a straight line to a point in the western line of Lot 4 of said Linda Vista Tract distant thereon seventy-five (75) feet from the northern line of Tunstead Avenue; thence southerly in a straight line to the northern line of Pine Street; thence diagonally and easterly across Pine Street to the northwest corner of Lot 23 of said Linda Vista Tract; thence southerly in a straight line to the northern line of Ross Avenue; thence southwesterly across Ross Avenue to the northwest corner of Lot 37 at Block 2 of Sunnyside Tract as shown on the map of said Tract recorded at Page 22 of Volume 1 of maps on file in the office of the County Recorder of Marin County; thence southerly in a straight line to the northern line of Mariposa Avenue; thence southwesterly across Mariposa Avenue to the northwest corner of Lot 22 Block 3 of said Sunnyside Tract; thence southerly in a straight line to the northwest corner of Lot 9 Block 3 of said Sunnyside Tract; thence easterly in a straight line to the northwest corner of Lot 7 Block 3 of said Sunnyside Tract; thence southerly in a straight line to the northern line of Belle Avenue; thence easterly along the northern line of Belle Avenue to the point of beginning.

Fire Zone No. 2 shall include such territory or portions of said Town as are included in the Commercial District as established by Ordinance No. 190 of said Town approved June 7, 1926, and in the additional Commercial District as established by Ordinance No. 193 of said Town approved November 15, 1926, and in the additional Commercial District as established by Ordinance No. 197 of said Town approved August 27, 1928, and in the additional

Commercial District as established by Ordinance No. 199 of said Town approved *March 4 1929*, and as are not included in Fire Zone No. 1 as hereinbefore bounded and described.

Fire Zone No. 3 shall include such territory or portions of said Town as are not included in Fire Zone No. 1 or Fire Zone No. 2 as hereinbefore bounded and described, or in Fire Zone No. 4 as hereinafter bounded and described.

Fire Zone No. 4 shall include such territory or portions of said Town as are included in the Industrial District as established by Ordinance No. 190 of said Town approved June 7, 1926 and as said Industrial District may have been enlarged, modified or restricted, by subsequent amendments of said Ordinance No. 190.

Section 3. This Ordinance shall be published once in the Marin Herald, a newspaper of general circulation printed and published in said Town of San Anselmo.

I hereby approve the foregoing ordinance this 3rd day of September, 1929.
