

RESOLUTION DECLARING THE CANVASS OF RETURNS AND RESULTS OF GENERAL MUNICIPAL ELECTION HELD ON APRIL 8, 1952.

WHEREAS a General Municipal Election was held on the 18th day April 1952, as required by law, and

WHEREAS it appears that notice of said election was duly and legally given as required by law, and voting precincts were properly established; that election officials were duly appointed and served and election supplies furnished and that in all respects said election was held and conducted and the votes thereat received and canvassed and the returns thereof made and declared in the time, form, and manner required by the Election Code of the State of California governing elections in cities of the sixth class, and,

WHEREAS the City Council of the Town of San Anselmo met at the council chambers in said Town of San Anselmo on Tuesday, the 15th day of April 1952, to canvass the returns of said election and to install the newly elected officers and as a result of which, the Council finds that the number of votes, the names of the persons voted for, and other matters required by law, to be as hereinafter stated,

NOW THEREFORE, be it resolved as follows: That the said General Municipal Election was held and conducted in the Town of San Anselmo on Tuesday, the 8th day of April, 1952, in the time, form, and manner as required by law, that there were six voting precincts established for the purpose of holding said election, consisting of a consolidation of the regular election precincts for holding state and county elections, as follows to-wit:

CONSOLIDATED VOTING PRECINCT "A", comprising State and County Precincts No. 213, 217, 230 and 231 and the polling place thereof shall be the Wade Thomas School, 115 Kensington Road.

CONSOLIDATED VOTING PRECINCT "B", comprising State and County Precincts 218, 219, and 232, and the polling place thereof shall be at the City Hall, San Anselmo Avenue.

CONSOLIDATED VOTING PRECINCT "C", comprising State and County Precincts No. 215, and 233, and the polling place thereof shall be the Myers Roofing Service and Supply Co., 201 Redhill Avenue.

CONSOLIDATED VOTING PRECINCT "D", comprising State and County precincts No. 214, 216, 226/<sup>and 234</sup> and the polling place thereof shall be the Isabel Cook School on Sir Francis Drake Blvd. between Los Angeles Avenue and Sonoma Avenue.

CONSOLIDATED VOTING PRECINCT "E", comprising State and County Precincts 220, 223, 224, 227, 228, and 238 and the polling place thereof shall be the Yolandsdale School on San Anselmo Avenue at Elm Avenue.

CONSOLIDATED VOTING PRECINCT "F", comprising State and County Precincts No. 221, 222, 225, 229, 235, 236 and 237 and the polling place thereof shall be the Brookside School, Brookmead Court.

That the whole number of votes cast in said Town of San Anselmo was 1545: that the names of the persons voted for, the offices to be filled at said election, together with the whole number of votes which they received in the entire Town is as follows, to-wit:

Be it further resolved that at said General Municipal Election, Arthur W. Smith and Fraser Gudworth were elected to the office of Councilmen of the Town of San Anselmo for the full term of four years. Walter G. Thompson was elected to the office of treasurer of the said Town for a term of four years. Irma B. Anderson was elected to the office of City Clerk for a full term of four years.

The Clerk of the Town of San Anselmo is hereby ordered, as required by law, to enter on the records of the City Council of the said Town, a statement of the result of said election, showing:

1. The whole number of the votes cast in the City.
2. The names of the persons voted for.
3. The measures voted upon.
4. For what office each person was voted for.
5. The number of votes given at each precinct to each person, and for and against each measure.
6. The number of votes given in the City to each person, and for and against each measure.


The Clerk shall thereupon make and deliver to each of the persons elected a certificate of election signed by him and fully authenticated; he shall impose the constitutional oath of office and have each elected person subscribe his name thereto, whereupon each said elected person shall be inducted into the office to which he has been elected.
