RESOLUTION CALLING SPECIAL ELECTION

WHEREAS, on the 10 day of May, 1949, a petition demanding the recall of RICHARD E. LOVE as a member of the City Council of the Town of San Anselmo has been submitted by the Clerk of the Town of San Anselmo to the City Council pursuant to the provisions of Section 11,114 of the Elections Code of the State of California, which said petition contains the Certificate of Sufficiency of said City Clerk that said petition contains the required number of signatures of voters of the Town of San Anselmo so as to require a recall election, and

WHEREAS, on the 10 day of May, 1949, a petition demanding the recall of CECIL J. ALLEN as a member of the City Council of the Town of San Anselmo has been submitted by the Clerk of the Town of San Anselmo to the City Council pursuant to the provisions of Section 11,114 of the Elections Code of the State of California, which said petition contains the Certificate of Sufficiency of said City Clerk that said petition contains the required number of signatures of voters of the Town of San Anselmo so as to require a recall election, and

WHEREAS, it appears that each of the foregoing petitions conforms to the requirements of Section 11,101 et seq. of the Elections Code of the State of California, and

WHEREAS, it appears that the legislative body should, pursuant to the provisions of Section 11,114 of the Elections Code, order a special election to be held to determine whether the voters will recall the officers above-named sought to be recalled,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the Town of San Anselmo that a special municipal election be held in said Town of San Anselmo on Wed. day, the 15 day of June, 1949, for the purpose of submitting to the voters and electors of the Town of San Anselmo the following propositions or measures, to-wit:

and the polling place thereof shall be at
Falk's Garage
1554 Sir Francis Drake Boulevard at Butterfield Road
in the Town of San Anselmo;

CONSOLIDATED VOTING PRECINCT "H"

Comprising State and County Precincts Nos. 222 and 229
and the polling place thereof shall be at
Brookside School
Off Butterfield Road at Brookmead Court
in the Town of San Anselmo;

CONSOLIDATED VOTING PRECINCT "I"

Comprising State and County Precincts Nos. 225 and 227
and the polling place thereof shall be at
Drake School
Sir Francis Drake Boulevard at Saunders Avenue
in the Town of San Anselmo;

CONSOLIDATED VOTING PRECINCT "J"

Comprising State and County Precincts Nos. 217
and the polling place thereof shall be at
Perry Sunnyside Nursery
130 Sir Francis Drake Boulevard
in the Town of San Anselmo.


