

RESOLUTION NO. 494

DECLARING CANVASS OF RETURNS, AND RESULTS OF SPECIAL
MUNICIPAL ELECTION HELD MAY 19, 1950.

WHEREAS, the City Council of the Town of San Anselmo, by Ordinance, duly called and ordered held in said City an election on the 19th day of May, 1950, for the purpose of submitting to the qualified voters and electors thereof the measure hereinafter set forth; and

WHEREAS, said ordinance calling and ordering said election was duly posted in three (3) public places in the Town of San Anselmo (there being no newspaper published in said Town) as required by law and by said ordinance, as appears from the affidavit of posting now on file in the office of the City Clerk of the Town of San Anselmo; and

WHEREAS, it appears that said special municipal election was duly held in accordance with law and with said call, on the said 19th day of May, 1950, as aforesaid, and that the polls for said election were kept open during the time required by law, and that said election was held and conducted, and the votes thereat received and canvassed, and the returns thereof ascertained, determined and declared, all as provided by the laws of the State of California and by said ordinance; and

WHEREAS, on this day, to wit, the 23rd day of May, 1950, at the hour of 8:00 o'clock P. M., the City Council of the Town of San Anselmo met at its usual place of meeting and has canvassed the returns of said special municipal election as required by law, and the result of said canvass is found to

IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED, DETERMINED AND DECLARED by the City Council of the Town of San Anselmo as follows:

1. That at said special municipal bond election the following measure for incurring bonded indebtedness was submitted to the electors of said Town of San Anselmo and that the number of votes given in said municipality for and against said measure was as follows:

<p><u>MEASURE:</u> Shall the Town of (Park Improvement) San Anselmo incur a bonded indebtedness in the principal amount of \$60,000 for the acquisition, construction and completion of the following municipal improvement, to wit: Improvement of SAN ANSELMO MEMORIAL PARK, including lighting facili- ties, grandstands, grandstand roofs, culverts and drainage facilities, store house, tool house, dressing and shower room improvements, playground and recrea- tional equipment and apparatus, and other works, property or structures necessary or convenient for the improvement of said public park?</p>	<u>476</u>	<u>790</u>

2. That the total number of votes cast at said special municipal bond election was 1269 votes. That 3 ballots were spoiled and not counted.

3. That by said ordinance calling said special municipal bond election the Town of San Anselmo was divided into four (4) special election precincts, and that the number of votes cast in each precinct for and against said measure was as follows:

4. That more than two-thirds of all of the votes cast at said special municipal bond election were in favor of said measure and authorized the incurring of a bonded debt for the purpose set forth therein, and that said measure *failed to* ~~carried~~. *CARRY.*

5. That the City Clerk of the Town of San Anselmo be, and is hereby, instructed to enter this resolution on the minutes of this City Council as a statement of the result of said election.


