Red Hill Park Update: Childs reported that the fundraising committee had received information that the Marin Community Foundation (MCF) had awarded \$325k to the Red Hill Community Park (RHCP) project. Additionally, Childs reported that Marin County Supervisor Hal Brown had committed an additional \$100k bring the total to approximately \$1.5m. He reported that the Tamalpais Union High School District is waiting the results of bids for other projects to determine if there is additional school bond money for RHCP.

Staff Update: Long reported that the Memorial Park tennis courts project was delayed due to the need to re-engineer the courts and the pathway closest to Sunny Hills Drive. He stated that the Public Works Department expects the courts to be finished by early September.

Kelly asked about the status of the Memorial Park restroom renovation. Long indicated that the project has gone out to bid and the scope of the project included rehabilitating the existing structure rather than replacing it. Kelly also requested that the restrooms at the Isabel Cook Center be opened more frequently, especially on weekends.

Long presented the Fall 2007 Recreation Guide to the commission and highlighted the new program offerings.

Commissioner Comments: Coleman reported that the Ross Valley Seniors (RVS) had an event that featured a local author giving a presentation to approximately 25 seniors.
