I have been the Chief Polling Inspector at the Fairfax Library and worked with the Marin Registrar of Voters office for approximately 11 years. I have not held a public office. My activities have been primarily of a volunteer or professional nature.

Reasons for this appointment:

I care passionately about libraries, and naturally, my town's library. When my son and I moved here 17 years ago, the very first thing we did after receiving proof of residence, was march to the library and get our cards. I believe our library sets and reflects the intellectual and cultural standards of the community, occupying a unique place in our town. I have much to contribute to its continued health and vibrancy.

What are your qualifications for this appointment:

I worked in the book business for 25 years. During my tenure at one of the top bookstores, I organized what was recognized as the best author series in the country; built a children's store within the store; and handled all publicity and community outreach activities. As a member of the League of Women Voters, I'm very involved with the Media Outreach (involved with the website and Facebook page, training in the making of documentaries, and learning how to stage candidate debates), International Relations and Healthcare committees - all focused on educating and informing the voters of this county.

I see the spending of the revenue from the recently approved parcel tax in visible and impressive ways that make a difference as one of the most important and challenging issues for the library.
