Re: Qualifications

My experience encompasses business, government and non-profit organizations. Briefly, I spent 22 years working for Blue Shield of California; nineteen of those years were in management with increasing responsibility. I retired from Blue Shield as a Vice President. I held that title in both operations and marketing. These positions had responsibility for managing a budget in excess of \$12 million dollars, employees in excess of 150. The skills I brought to these positions included communicating clarity of purpose, establishing guidelines for various positions and processes and establishing standards governing the relationships between managers, employees, outside contractors and customers.

Following my retirement in 1994, I joined the League of Women Voters, was elected to the board the following year and was elected president in 1998 for a three year term. While holding this position, I was the public face of the organization and managed various volunteer efforts so that they were aligned to the League's positions and while they continued to fulfill the individual member's desire to contribute to their community.

From 1996 to 2005 I was a board member for the Ross Valley Sanitary District (RVSD) and commissioner for the Central Marin Sanitary Agency (CMSA). In this role, I helped establish working relationships between the board and the management and staff of those two organizations. As a board member it is vital that clarity is used when establishing standards and rules governing how the organization staff relates to the public, the outside contractors, other agencies and to the board itself. Role definition and understanding is vital in order to have the most efficient and highest quality service provided to the public.

I was recently named to the Measure C Citizens' Oversight Committee of the College of Marin. This committee acts on behalf of the public to ensure Measure C bond funds are properly spent. I will attend my first meeting in September, 2012.

While working as a professional ballet dancer, I was able to share my passion for the performing arts teaching dance, theater, and english language to impoverished children in both Thailand and Ecuador. As a student of dance at Marin Ballet, I volunteered my dancing services, performing in numerous outreach programs at schools, hospitals, and senior homes, as well as teaching ballet to preschool age children in the San Rafael area. My desire to make art more accessible to the communities around me has extended beyond the dance world as well. I was an artist in the Italian Street Painting Festival in San Rafael, supporting the Youth in Arts program nearly every year since the inception in 1994, and also a featured fashion designer three times over in San Francisco's Discarded to the Divine Fashion Auction Event, helping to raise money for the St. Vincent de Paul Foundation. In addition I have also served as one of the San Rafael Rotary's Cultural Ambassadors to Japan, where I spent 3 weeks engaging in cultural exchange with my Japanese counterparts. I also think it could be great community builder to create some type of annual performing arts event, where anyone can take part sharing the talents they have, be it in the limelight or behind the scenes. Lastly, As I mentioned above, I took part for more than 10 years in Youth and Arts Italian Street Painting Festival which sadly has been canceled indefinitely much to the disappointment of many local artists and art aficionados. It could be interesting to take on the idea on a smaller scale and incorporate it into one of the existing festivals already going on in San Anselmo (the Art and Wine Festival Perhaps?).
