Dear Phil,

I have read the historical report submitted on the building at 535-541 San Anselmo Avenue. The report is quite detailed and well documents the history of the building. As noted, the most distinctive feature of the building is the mural by Jose Moya del Pino. This feature was previously identified by the Historical Commission as being worthy of protection and preservation. The plan of the current property owners to remove the mural and donate it to the Spain-USA Foundation so that it can be displayed at the San Francisco Spanish Consulate seems to accomplish this preservation, albeit not in a local setting.

I agree with the summary finding of the report, that the building has historical significance because of the art work it contains. If the mural is to be removed and preserved, then the building itself will lack historical significance and not meet the test for eligibility for the California Register of Historical Resources.

I would like to see the door handles at 535 donated to the town for the Historical Museum.
