

MINUTES OF JANUARY 16, 1922.

A Regular Adjourned meeting of the Board of Trustees was held on Monday evening, January 16, 1922 at 8 o'clock P. M.

Present, Trustees Foley, Stephenson, Hughes and Deysher.
Absent, " Hund.

The minutes of the meeting of January 3, 1922 were read and approved.

UNPAID BUSINESS LICENSES

The Town Marshal reported three unpaid business licenses for the year 1921. Upon motion of Trustee Foley, seconded by Trustee Stephenson, Licenses Nos. 412 (Wet Wash Laundry) and 349 (Dr. O.W. Jones) were ordered cancelled and the City attorney was directed to take steps to collect No. 373 (Marin Feed and Fuel Co.).

MEMBER OF MOSQUITO BOARD

Upon motion of Trustee Foley, seconded by Trustee Stephenson, Dr. O. W. Jones was re-appointed to succeed himself as the representative from the Town of San Anselmo upon the Board of Trustees of the Marin Mosquito Abatement District.

BARBER TRACT ROADS

Upon motion of Trustee Foley, seconded by Trustee Stephenson the City Engineer was directed to prepare plans and specifications for the improvement of the Roads in the Barber Tract under the Improvement Act of 1911 and the Improvement Bond act of 1915. (Trustee Hughes votes No.)

WOODLAND AVENUE SEWER

Upon motion of Trustee Foley, seconded by Trustee Stephenson the City Engineer was directed to prepare plans and specifications for the construction of a sewer in Woodland Avenue from the end of the present sewer in Cedar Street to San Anselmo Avenue under the Improvement Act of 1911.

AGREEMENT WITH R. R. CO. TO LOWER
CULVERT EAST OF YOLANDA STATION.

Trustee Foley introduced the following Resolution and moved its adoption, to wit:

RESOLVED that the President of the Board of Trustees and the Town Clerk be authorized to enter into an agreement with the Northwestern Pacific Railroad Company for the lowering of the Culvert across the Railroad Right of Way east of Yolanda Station and in rear of the Marple property, the work to be done by the Town of San Anselmo under the Supervision of the Railroad Company.

CHANGING OF STREET NAMES

Trustee Foley introduced the following Resolution and moved its adoption, to wit:

RESOLVED that the names of certain streets enumerated below be changed in accordance with the new names given herein:

That Bell Avenue in the Bush Tract be changed to Pastori Avenue,
 That Belle Vista Avenue in the Ross Valley Tract be changed
 to Vineyard Avenue.

That Claire Avenue in Floribel Park be changed to Floribel Avenue;
 That Grove Lane in Sequoia Park be changed to Juniper Avenue;

That Laurel Lane in the Linda Vista Tract be changed to City Hall
 Avenue;

That Laurel Road in Yolanda Court be changed to Alder Avenue;

That Madrone Road in the Bush Tract be changed to Merced Avenue;

That Oak Lane in Ross Valley Park be changed to Myrtle Avenue;

That Oak Street in the Bush Tract and Oak Avenue in the Grand
 View Tract be changed to Sierra Avenue;

That Prospect Avenue in the Bush Tract be changed to Humboldt Avenue

That Park Lane in Sequoia Park be changed to Earl Lane;

That Rose Lane in Karlshrue Park be changed to Brennfleck Avenue;

That Red Hill Avenue in the Latham Tract be changed to Spaulding
 Avenue;

That Redwood Road in the Davidson Tract and Redwood Avenue in
 Floribel and Oak Park be known as Redwood Road

That Scenic Avenue in Floribel Park be changed to Floribel Avenue;

That Yolanda Drive in the Kohn Tract be changed to Laurel Avenue;

That the San Rafael and Olema Road be changed to Red Hill Avenue;

That the Red Hill and Ross Landing Road be changed to Main Street;


That Scenic Avenue from the end of San Anselmo Avenue at Yolanda Sta
 Station to Forest Avenue, Forest Avenue from Scenic
 Avenue to Willow Avenue and Willow Avenue throughout its
 entire length be changed to San Anselmo Avenue.
