MINUTES OF JUNE 14TH, 1934.

A regular meeting of the Council of the Town of San Anselmo was held in San Anselmo on Thursday, June 14th, 1934, at the hour of 8 o'clock P.M.

The minutes of the two preceding meetings were approved as read.

A letter signed by the Tax Collector explaining a misunderstanding between himself and a tax payer in connection with his second installment of taxes, was read and upon motion of Councilman Linch, the Council authorized the cancellation of penalties and costs in the amount of \$1.98 levied against Assessment No. 973 of the 1933-34 Tax Roll. Motion was seconded by Councilman Dempsey and carried by the following vote:

Councilman Scotford introduced the following resolution and moved its adoption:

WHEREAS, the Town of San Anselmo has submitted plans and specifications for the improvement of portions of Red Hill Avenue and Sir Francis Drake Boulevard, known as Project No. 1, and

WHEREAS, Approval by the Director of Public Works is to be made in the form of an agreement setting forth final understandings, terms and commitments on extent of proposed work, method of financing and allocation of funds, jurisdiction over proposed expenditures and all further procedure, now therefore be it,

RESOLVED, that the Mayor as President of the City Council be, and is hereby authorized to sign all such necessary agreements on behalf of the Town of San Anselmo, with the Department of Public Works for the undertaking and completion of the aforementioned Project No. 1".

To confirm our several previous verbal conversations and agreement, the City Council has asked me to write you and place the matter on file as an official record.

I refer to the street widening program and repair on Red Hill Avenue and Sir Francis Drake Boulevard - the work to be done with the 1/4 cent gasoline tax allotment to San Anselmo and the \$1,500 participation by the County through your good self as Supervisor of this district.

We have delayed the work so as to permit you to have the funds available July 1st, as you requested.

We will appreciate your friendly action in transmitting the County Warrant to cover, at your early convenience, so that we may assure the State Highway department of the receipt of same.
