RESOLUTION NO. 710

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE  
MAYOR AND CITY CLERK TO EXECUTE, ON BEHALF  
OF THE CITY OF SAN ANSELMO, A CONTRACT WITH  
THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA AUTHORIZING AND DI-  
RECTING THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA TO COLLECT THE  
CITY UNIFORM SALES AND USE TAX IN THE CITY AND  
TO PAY THE STATE ITS CHARGES FOR SUCH COLLEC-  
TION SERVICES

WHEREAS: The County of Marin, State of California, did, on or about the 26th day of February, 1957, adopt an ordinance imposing a one per cent sales and use tax pursuant to the State of California Uniform Sales and Use Tax Law, with the imposition of said tax to be effective as of the first day of April, 1957, and

WHEREAS: The City of San Anselmo, having in full force and effect a local one per cent sales and use tax ordinance, is desirous of having the collection thereof made by the State Board of Equalization and to have said Board perform all functions incident to the administration, operation and enforcement of said ordinance commencing on the first day of April, 1957, and

WHEREAS: The City of San Anselmo has introduced, passed and adopted a Uniform Local Sales and Use Tax Ordinance in conformity to part 1.5 of Div. 2 of the Revenue and Taxation Code (Section 7200 et seq.), to become effective as of the first day of April, 1957, and

WHEREAS: Pursuant to the statutory requirements it is necessary in order to achieve collection of the sales and use tax by the State of California, that a contract be entered into by and between this City and this State, prior to the effective date of said Uniform Sales and Use Tax Ordinance, to have the

State or the State Board of Equalization perform all functions incident to the administration or operation of the Uniform Sales and Use Tax Ordinance of this City, and

WHEREAS: A proposed contract between the State Board of Equalization and this City for the said purposes has been presented to the City Council of the City of San Anselmo for its acceptance and execution.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved as follows:

(1) That the facts stated in the premises hereof are true, and

(2) That the proposed contract between this City and the State Board of Equalization is fair and reasonable and the execution thereof by this City is to and for the best interests and welfare of this City, and

(3) That the Mayor and City Clerk of the City of San Anselmo are hereby authorized, empowered and directed to forthwith execute on behalf of the City of San Anselmo the said proposed contract with the State Board of Equalization and affix thereto the seal of this City, and

(4) That the City Clerk is directed to cause said executed contract to be in the hands of the State Board of Equalization forthwith.
