

Ordinance # 3

Ordinance

The Board of Trustees of the Town of San Anselmo do ordain as follows

Section 1 - All ordinances must be presented in writing and read at a regular meeting or a regularly adjourned meeting at least five (5) days before they are finally acted upon. After the first presentation and reading of an ordinance it must be filed with the clerk and must remain in his custody subject to the inspection of the public for at least five days, and until the next regular meeting or regularly adjourned meeting of the Board of Trustees, when it must again be read and finally voted upon, or action postponed.

Section 2 - Every ordinance shall be signed by the President of the Board of Trustees, attested by the clerk, and posted in at least three public places in the Town of San Anselmo; provided that the clerk shall file with each ordinance in the Ordinance Book an affidavit of the posting of said ordinance.

This ordinance shall take effect from and after the date of its passage.
