

Ordinance #12

An Ordinance to provide for the Licensing of Business carried on in the Town of San Anselmo; for the purpose of Revenue and Regulation.

The Board of Trustees of the Town of San Anselmo do ordain as follows:

Section 1 It shall be unlawful for any person, persons, association or corporation whether as principal officer, clerk, servant, agent or employee, either for themselves or any person, persons, association or corporation or otherwise, to engage in, conduct or carry on any business, exhibition, trade, occupation or calling in the Ordinance specified, without having first procured a license from said Town so to do, as provided in this Ordinance, and if any such person, persons, associations or corporations either as principal, officer, clerk, servant, agent or employee shall engage in, conduct or carry on any such business, exhibition, trade, occupation or calling hereinafter mentioned, without having first procured such license shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor, and upon conviction thereof shall be punished by a fine of not less than five (\$5) dollars or more than three hundred dollars (\$300) or by imprisonment for a term not exceeding three months, or by both such fine and imprisonment.

Section 2 The Marshal shall collect all licenses and as compensation for his services shall be entitled to five per cent of the amount collected.

Section 3 It shall be the duty of the Town Clerk to keep just and true accounts of all business in relation to the collection of licenses. He shall have general supervision over the collection of licenses, and shall

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 that the provisions of this article are properly enforced. As full compensation for all services rendered the clerk shall be entitled to five per cent. of all amounts collected.

Section 4 Licenses may issue for the term of three, six or twelve months, and for such other terms as may be required by this article.

Section 5 That the rates of license for the business, exhibition, trade, occupation or calling hereinafter named be and the same are hereby established within the Town of San Anselmo, and the same shall be paid by the owners or proprietors thereof, or the person liable therefor as follows, that is to say:

(A) Every person, firm or corporation, who, at a fixed place of business, sells any goods, wares or merchandise or transacts any other secular business within the Town limits shall pay a license tax of five dollars $\{5^{00}\}$ per quarter year.

(B) Every person, firm or corporation having no regularly established place of business in said town for the sale of merchandise or other goods and who delivers spirituous, vinous, malt or mixed liquors, within said town Twenty-five dollars $\{25^{00}\}$ per quarter year.

(C) Every person, firm or corporation that transports either for hire or delivers from a store situated within or without the town, baggage, packages or goods, wares or merchandise to or from different locations in said town shall pay a license tax as follows:

For each single wagon \$2.50 per year.

" " double " 5.00 " "

" " four horse team 10.00 " "

(D) From every person, firm or corporation letting out any hall, or other room for purpose of dancing therein or any other form of amusement the sum of \$20⁰⁰ per year.

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Provided, however, that no license shall be issued to any person, firm or corporation to let out a hall for said purpose, until such person shall have first filed an affidavit that said hall is constructed in the manner provided by Ordinance # 7 entitled "Relating to Exits" and it shall satisfactorily appear to this Board that said hall is so constructed that human life will not be endangered by the use thereof in the manner by which it is designed to be used.

This ordinance shall take effect immediately.
