

Ordinance # 21

Providing for the licensing of Bowling Alleys

The Board of Trustees of the Town of San Anselmo do ordain as follows.

Section 1 Every person, firm, association or corporation who conducts or carries on in the Town of San Anselmo, any bowling alley, billiard or pool room shall procure a license therefor from the Town Marshall and pay for such license the sum of Five Dollars (\$5.00) per quarter.

Section 2 Every person, firm or corporation who shall violate any of the provisions of this Ordinance shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor, and upon conviction thereof shall be punished by a fine not exceeding Fifty Dollars (\$50.00) or by imprisonment for a period not exceeding thirty days or by both such fine and imprisonment.

This Ordinance shall take effect from and after the date of its passage.
