

"Relating to the interference with water hydrants"

The Board of Trustees of the Town of San Anselmo do ordain as follows:—

Section 1. No person except a duly authorized official of the Town of San Anselmo, or a member of the regular Fire Department in the performance of his duty, shall in any manner interfere with the water hydrants or stand pipes within the Town of San Anselmo.

Section 2. Any violation of this Ordinance shall constitute a misdemeanor and each offense shall be punishable by a fine not exceeding One Hundred (\$100.00) Dollars, or imprisonment not exceeding three (3) months or by both such fine and imprisonment.

This Ordinance shall take effect from and after the date of its passage.
