

Ordinance # 24

"Relating to the carrying of concealed weapons"

The Board of Trustees of the Town of San Anselmo do ordain as follows:—

Section 1 It is hereby declared to be unlawful for any persons, other than a public officer, or person having duly secured a permit so to do, to wear or carry concealed on or about his person any pistol, dirk, or other dangerous or deadly weapon.

Section 2 The Board of Trustees of the Town of San Anselmo shall grant a written permit to any peaceable person, when in their judgment they may deem it necessary for such person to carry concealed weapons for his own personal protection.

Section 3 Any person violating any of the provisions of this Ordinance shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor, and upon conviction thereof, shall be punished by a fine not exceeding Three Hundred (\$300.00) Dollars, or by imprisonment for a term not exceeding three (3) months, or by both such fine and imprisonment.

This Ordinance shall take effect from and after the date of its passage.
